Physical Development

We are learning to:

- Hold a pencil correctly.

- Hear new vocabulary and use the words we have learnt
- Begin to write our own names

- Compare two small groups of up to five objects.
- Begin to recognise numbers 0-10.
- Count in order using one number name for each item.
- Discuss the length of objects.

- Plant seeds.
- Look at growing conditions.
- Show care and concern for living things.

We are learning to:

- Understand and answer simple questions such as "who", "what", "where".
- Understand and follow simple instructions.
- Retell a simple event in the correct order.
