What we're learning next half term

English

We are studying the text Beowulf that links with our topic of Vikings and Anglo Saxons in History. We will be looking at ways to write from different characters points of view.

Maths

In maths next half term, we will continue looking at fractions and multiplication and division, multiplying a 4 digit number by a 2 digit number. We will also begin decimals and percentages.

History
