PSHEE - This half term we are excited to be starting a new unit of work using The Story Project reading a story about mental health. RE -During this half term we will look at the question 'Why are some journeys and places special?'

What we're learning next half term We are studying the text Beowulf that links with our topic of Vikings and Anglo Saxons in History. We will be looking English at ways to write from different characters points of view. In maths next half term, we will continue looking at fractions and multiplication and division, multiplying a 4 Maths digit number by a 2 digit number. We will also begin decimals and percentrages. The children will begin their topic of Vikings and Anglo History Saxons. We will look at why the Anglo Saxons settled in Britain, their art and culture and also religions followed.
