Science

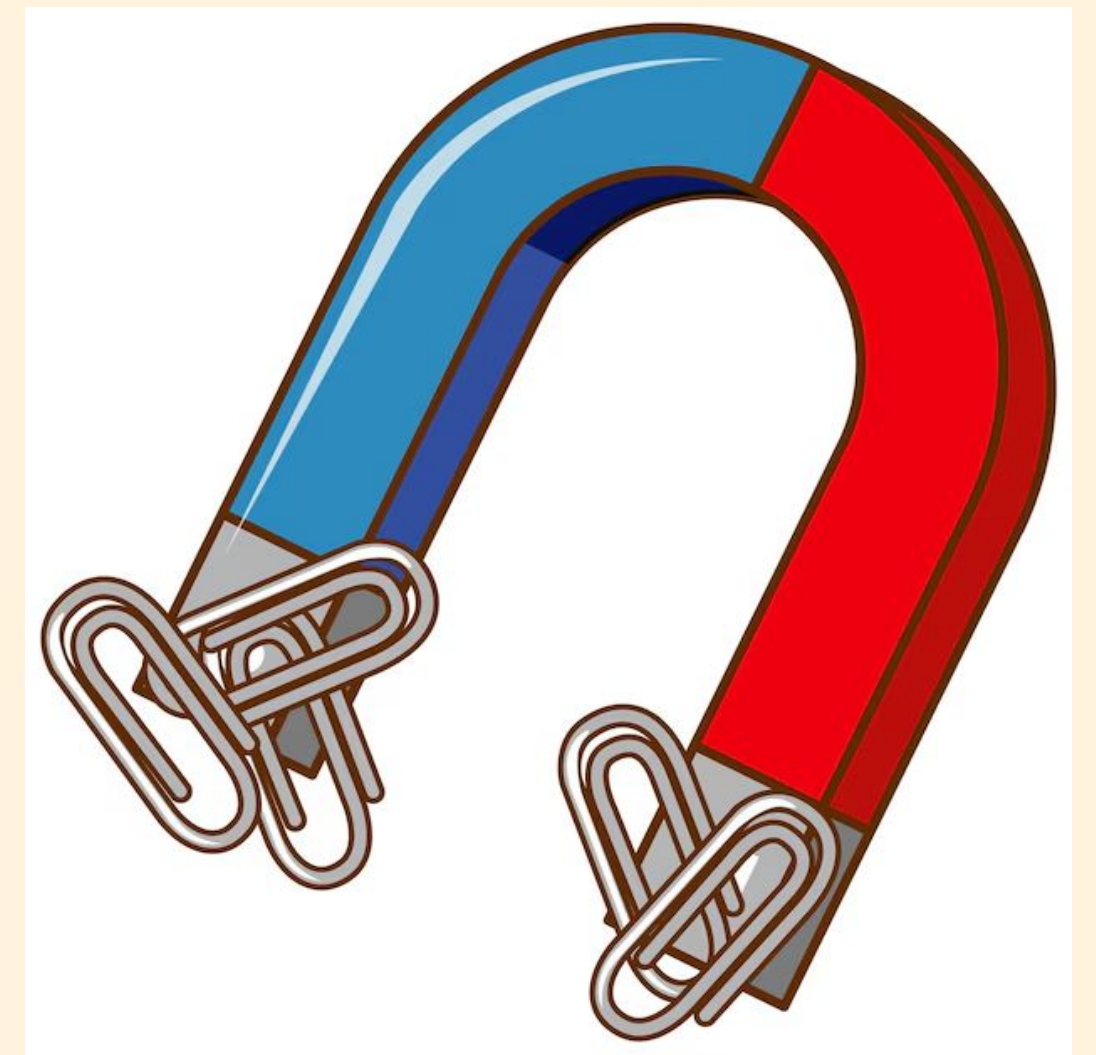
Year 3 have been investigating which materials are magnetic!

English

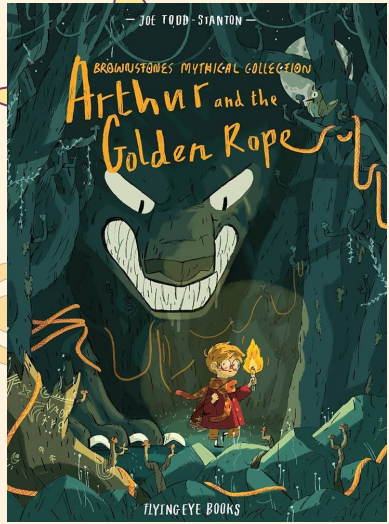
We have been working really hard to understand what a sentence is. We know they must include a subject and a verb.
