


Nursery

We have been counting to 3 and looking for the number 3


around the nursery.

Also we have been listening to the story of the Owl Babies, Sarah, Percy and Bill.










Reception




Reception have had so much back at school and getting back into our routines.


In literacy we have started reading our story 'Dinosaurs in the supermarket'.

In maths we have been looking at representing numbers.













Year 1 have started to read The Man on the Moon by Simon Bartram We are excited to continue the book next week and learn more about Bob.

In science we are exploring different materials. We looked at different objects around school and identified what material they were made of.













In English We started our new story for the half term: Claude in the City. It's a funny story about a daft dog called Claude!


In maths we have been identifying coins and notes.

In science we have been learning about materials and their properties.


















Year 3 have started to read Escape from Pompeii. We are already beginning to make links to our new geography topic about volcanoes and earthquakes.

In geography, we looked at the different layers of the earth. These are the inner core, outer core, mantle and crust.
















In writing, we have begun to look at our new text 'The Rhythm of the Rain'. We created freeze frames of the different scenes within the book.





In science, we carried out an investigation looking at the properties of solids. We discovered a solid has a fixed shape and volume.








We are so excited to have started our new text

Beowulf should do.












In History we have started our new topic on Anglo Saxons which has helped us in writing and reading lessons!
