In nursery we have been making snowmen out of play dough and building a home for the penguins out of sugar cubes.






# Reception

In science we looked at different pets people have and which pets belong to different animal groups. We used a tallying method to find out how many pets we had in our class.

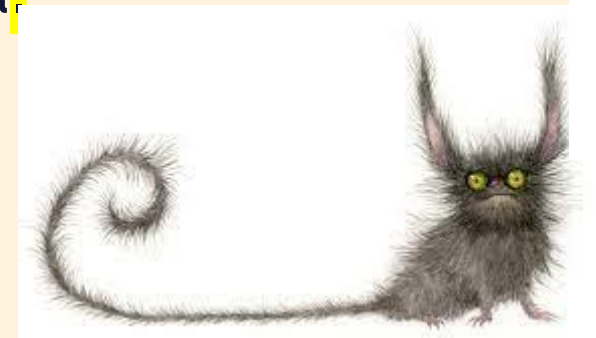


# Year 2

In English we have been writing our own character descriptions based on a character we have invented.

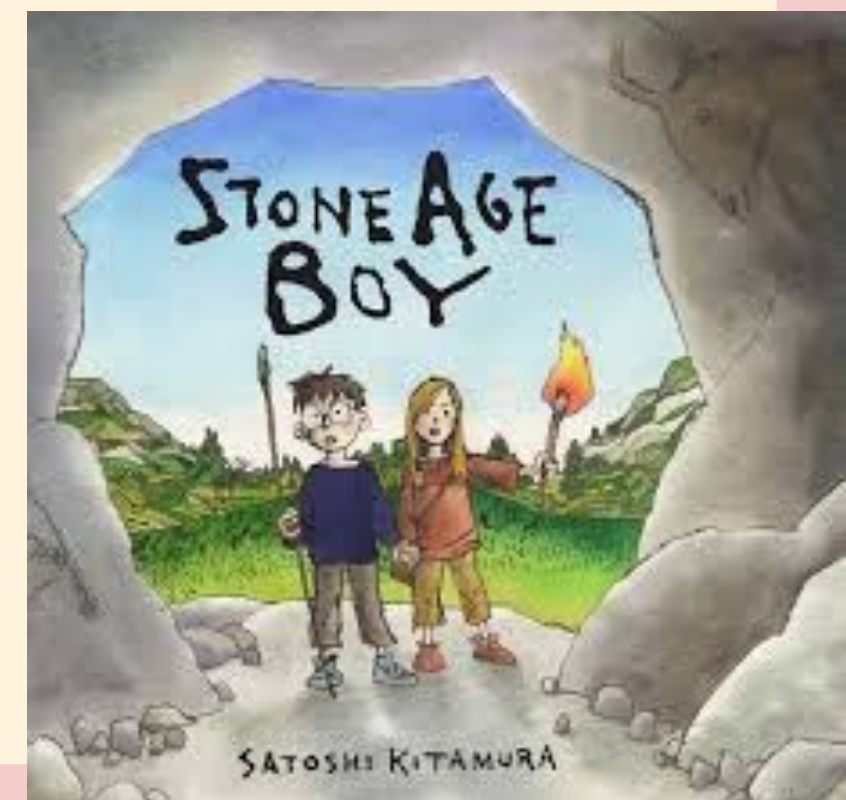


# Year 3

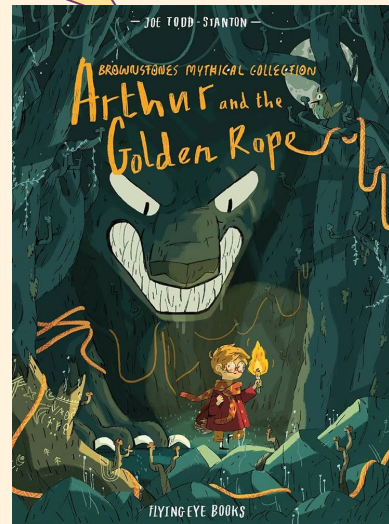

# Year 5

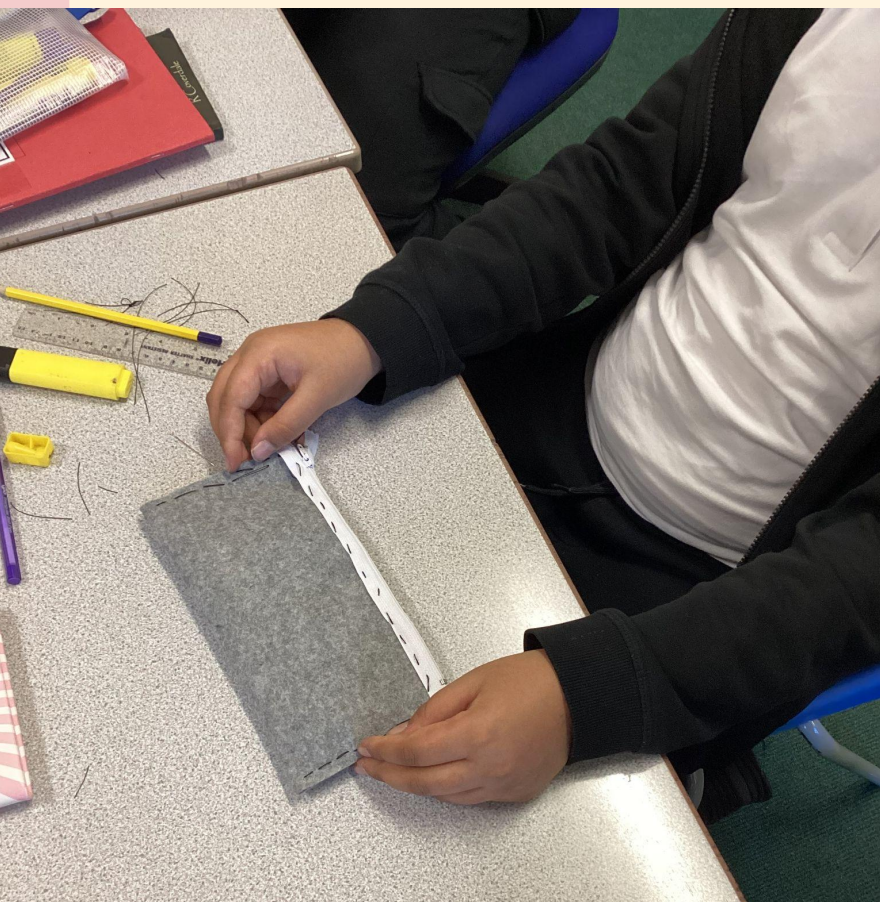
Year 5 have been busy making their pencil cases for DT. We practiced our sewing skills and had to be very creative in thinking of a personal design.
