Kipper's birthday. We even made a cake.

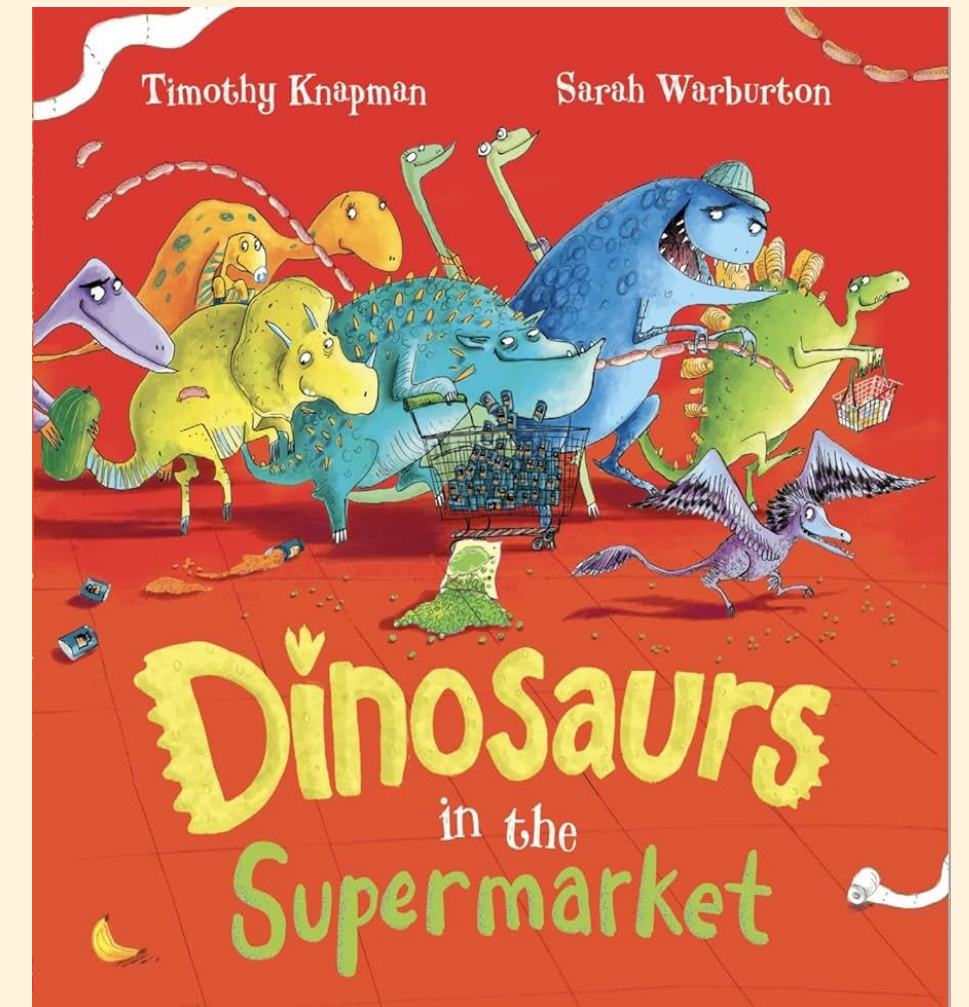


Reception

In English we have continued to read 'Claude and the city' and learned how to use 'first person' as if we were Claude speaking.

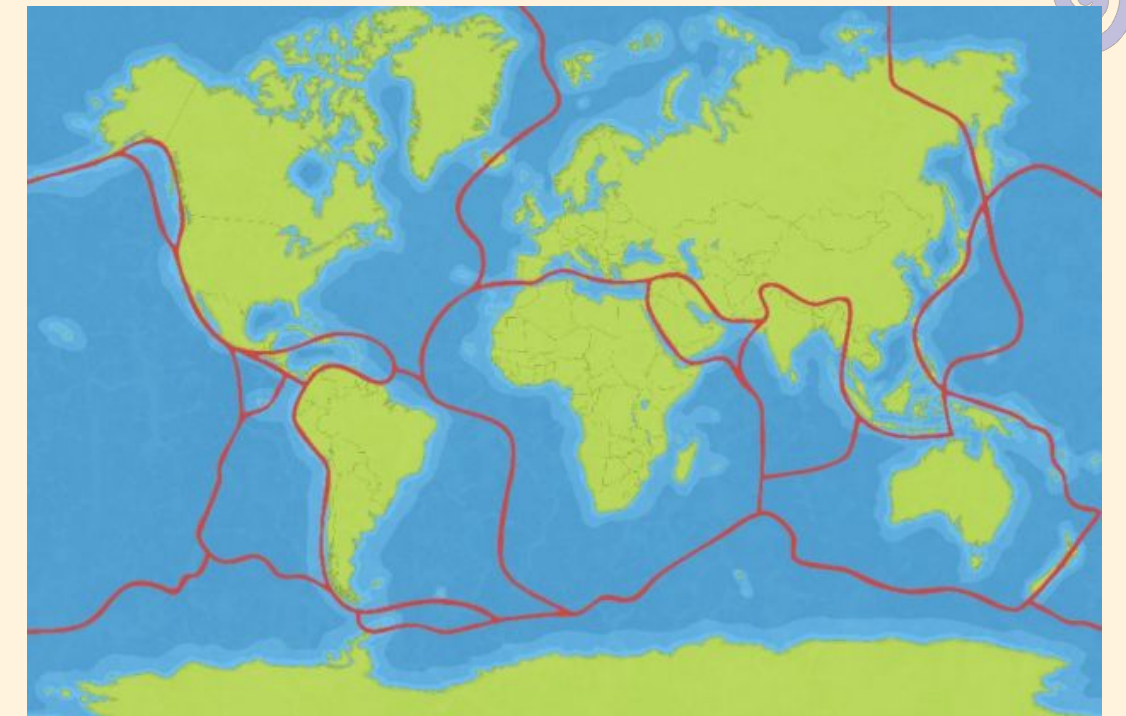
We have enjoyed learning about money in maths even though it has been tricky! We have used coins to buy different items.

In history we have started our new topic and began looking at Florence Nightingale and why she is significant.













Year 3

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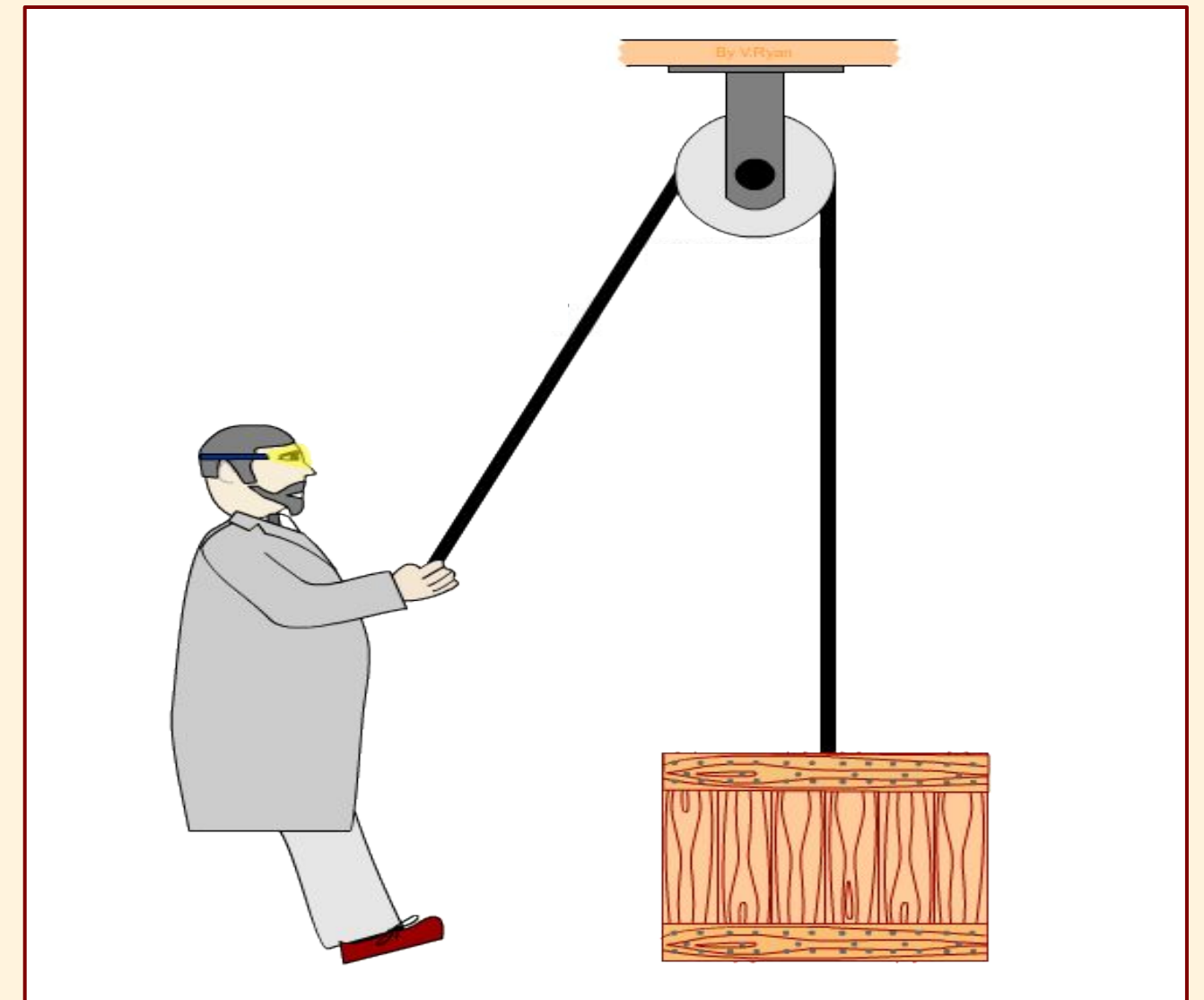
Year 5
