Nursery




This week we have been very busy.




We finished reading Kipper's Birthday so celebrated by having a small birthday party. We had balloons and played some party games, sang Happy Birthday and had some juice.

Reception

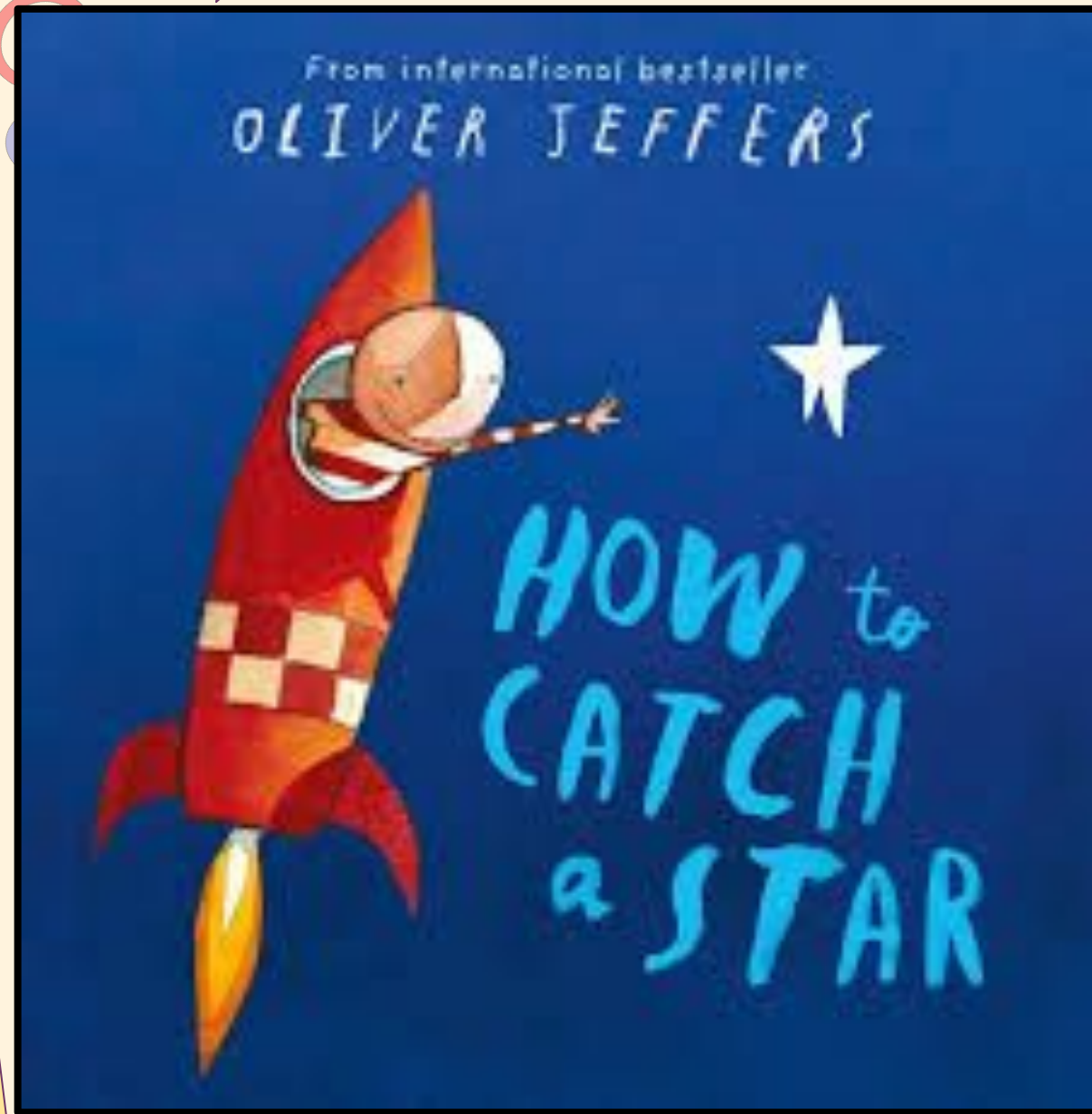

Year 1



Year 1 have enjoyed exploring our new book How to catch a star by Oliver Jeffers. We have thought of imaginative ways to catch our own star and what we might do with the star when we catch it.

In maths, we have been deepening our understanding of numbers up to 20. We have been ordering and comparing numbers and looking at how to represent these numbers using different equipment.

We have continued to explore different materials and we have learnt some new vocabulary that helps us to describe the properties of these materials.

In maths we have started a new unit on multiplication.

We have used play dough twice this week! In art to practice different methods of moulding clay and in science to understand the meaning of twisting, bending, stretching and squashing materials.

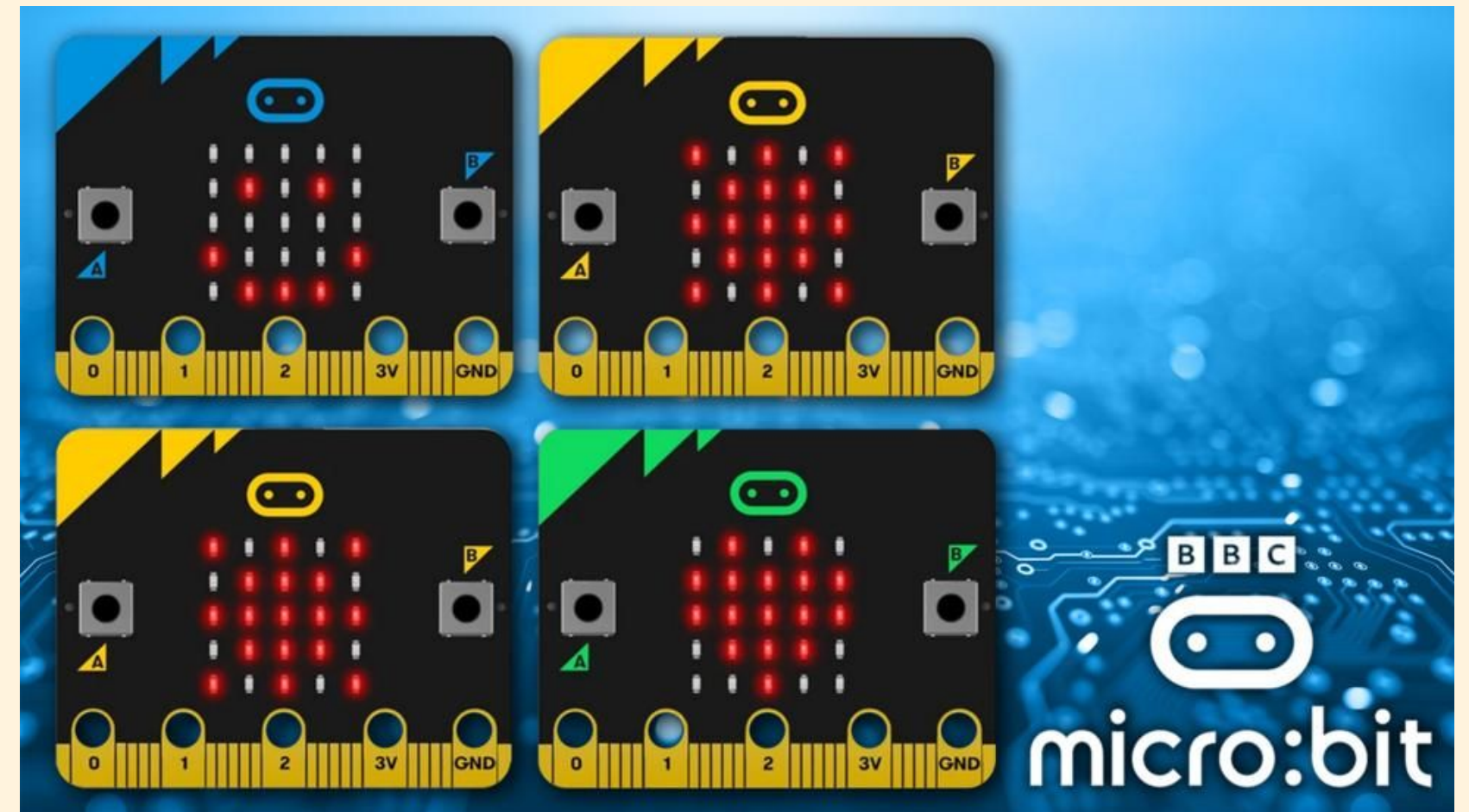


Year 3
