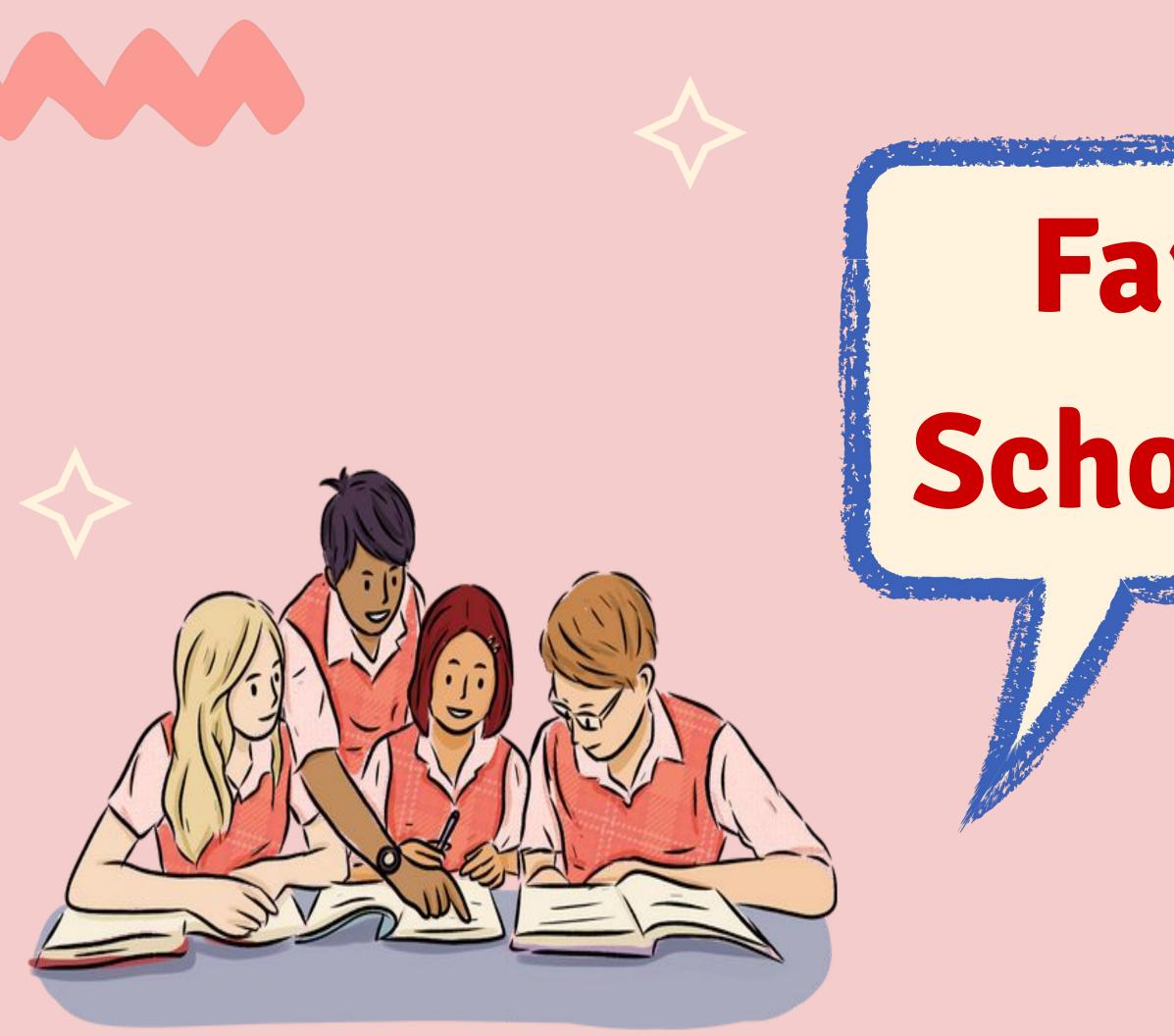
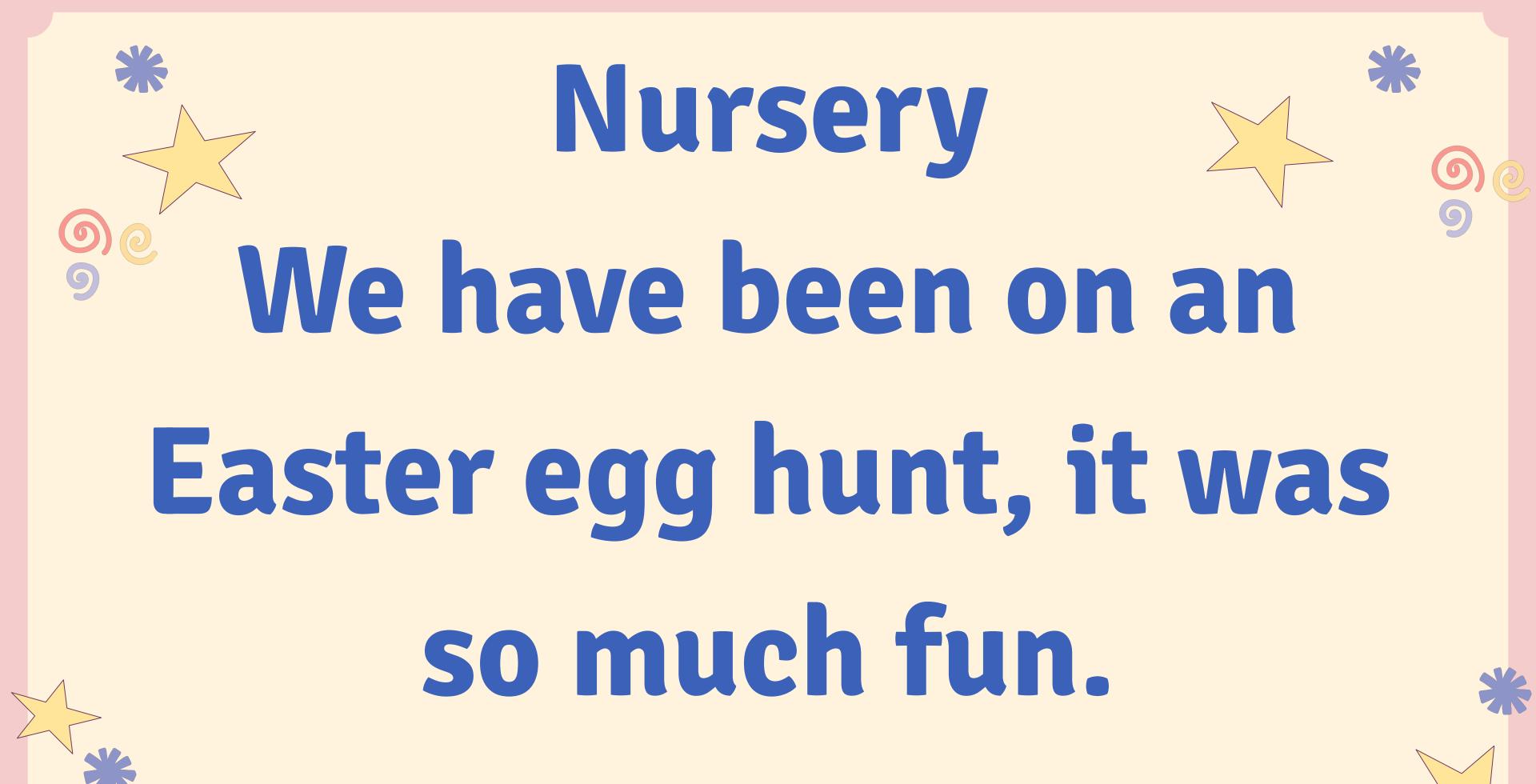

to memorise their names and properties.



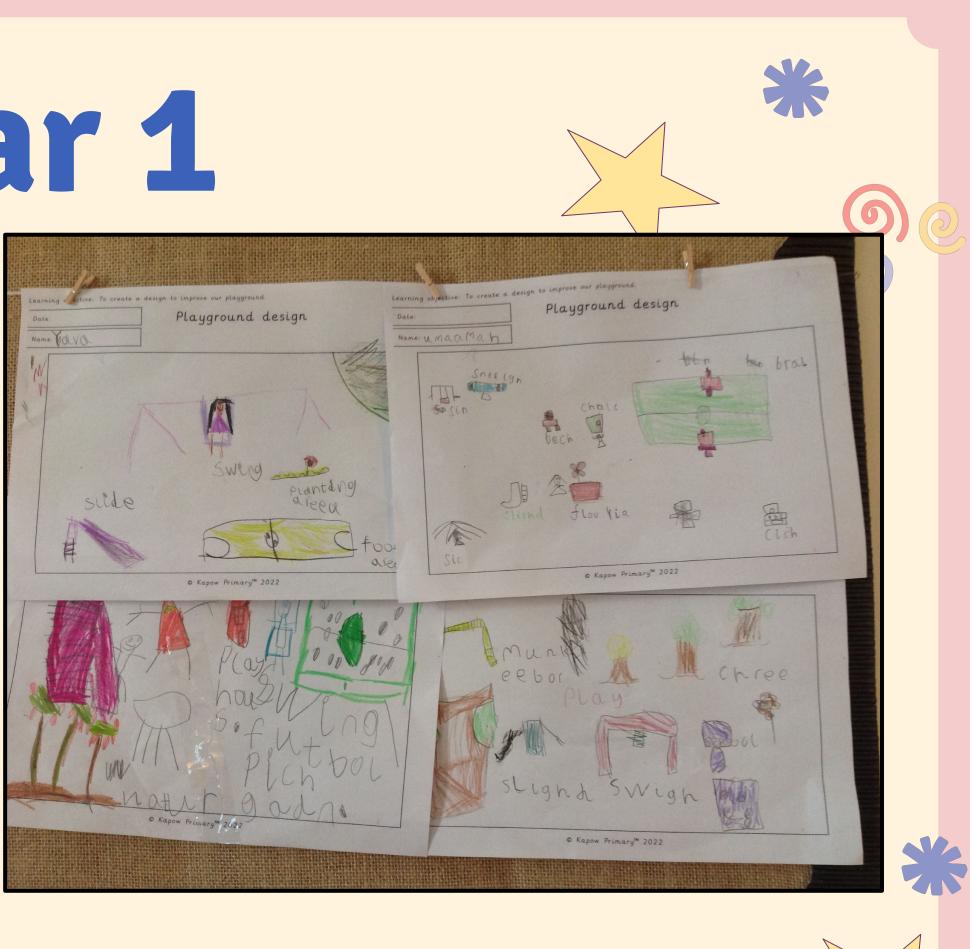


#### Year 1

In geography, we thought about the improvements we might like to make to our playground and drew our own maps.







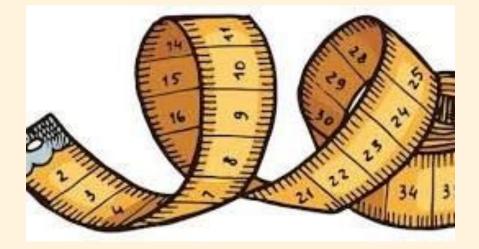
We finished making our fire engines in DT.

In English we performed our news reports in front of the class.

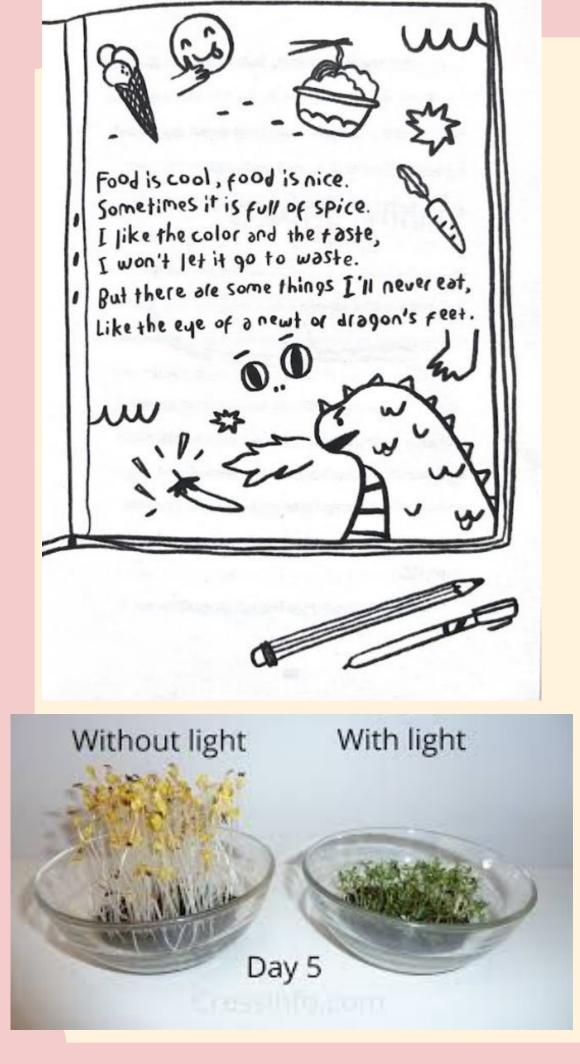
In maths, we have completed our unit on measure and have been consolidating our learning using Century.

In writing, we have begun writing up our leaflets about our holiday destination, we have been working really hard to include our grammatical features.

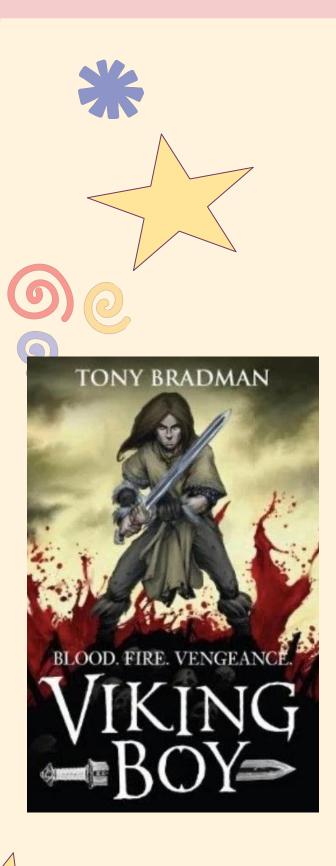
In maths, we begun our work on decimals. We have been looking at tenths and hundredths as fractions and decimals.

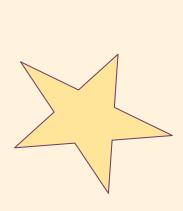


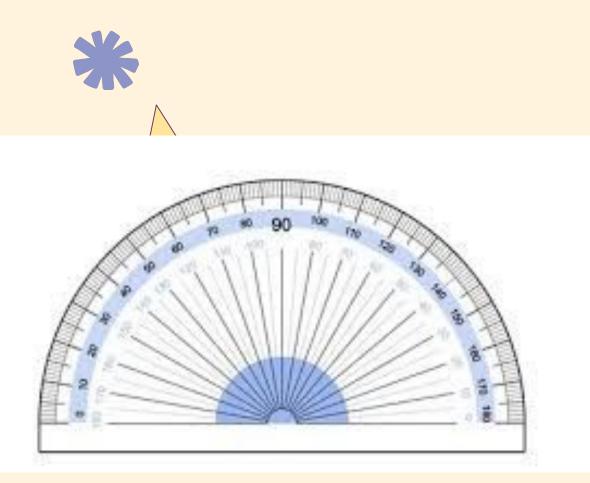
#### Year 5
