It's all about the 'Colour Monster' this week.

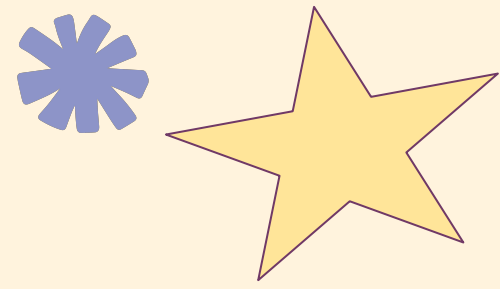
He has a different colour for each of his feelings. So we have been thinking about our feelings and talking about how it's ok to feel sad, happy or even angry sometimes.



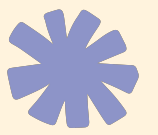
Reception

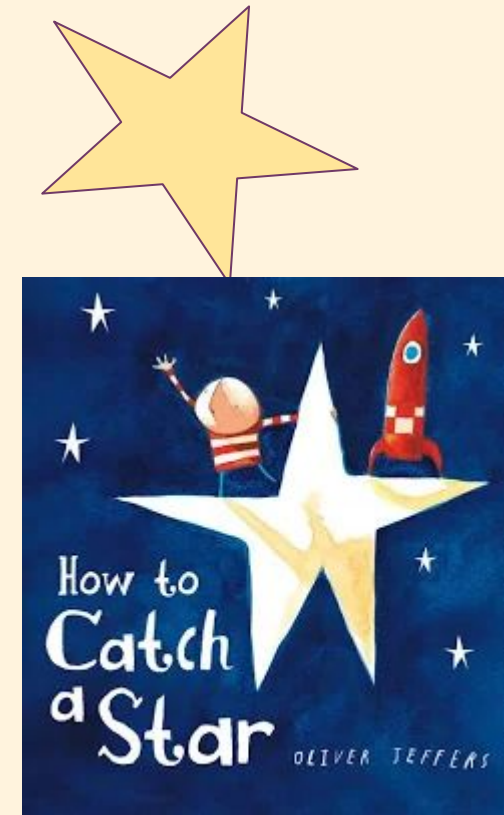




Year 1

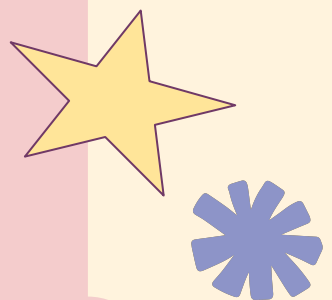
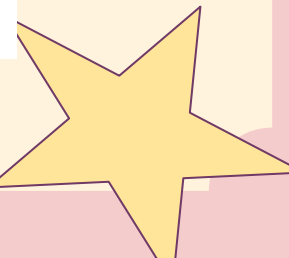
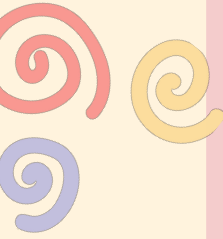


In English, we began reading how to catch a star by Oliver Jeffers. We made predictions about how the boy in the story would catch the star.

In science, we investigated whether distance affects how well you can hear.

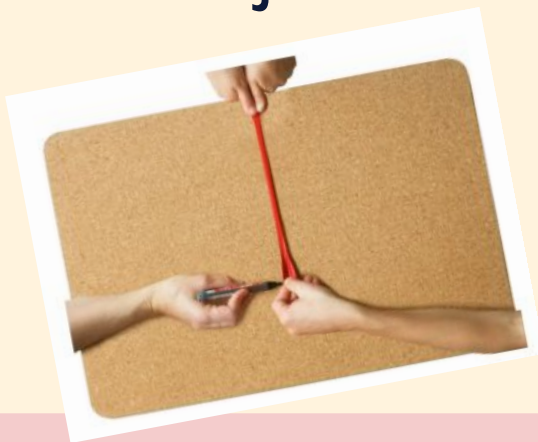


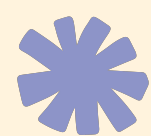
Year 2

In science we carried out an experiment to find out which material was the stretchiest. We had to measure accurately and each person had a specific job to do!



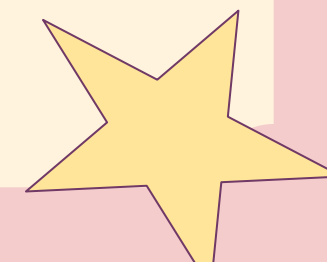
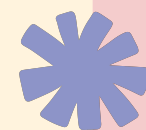
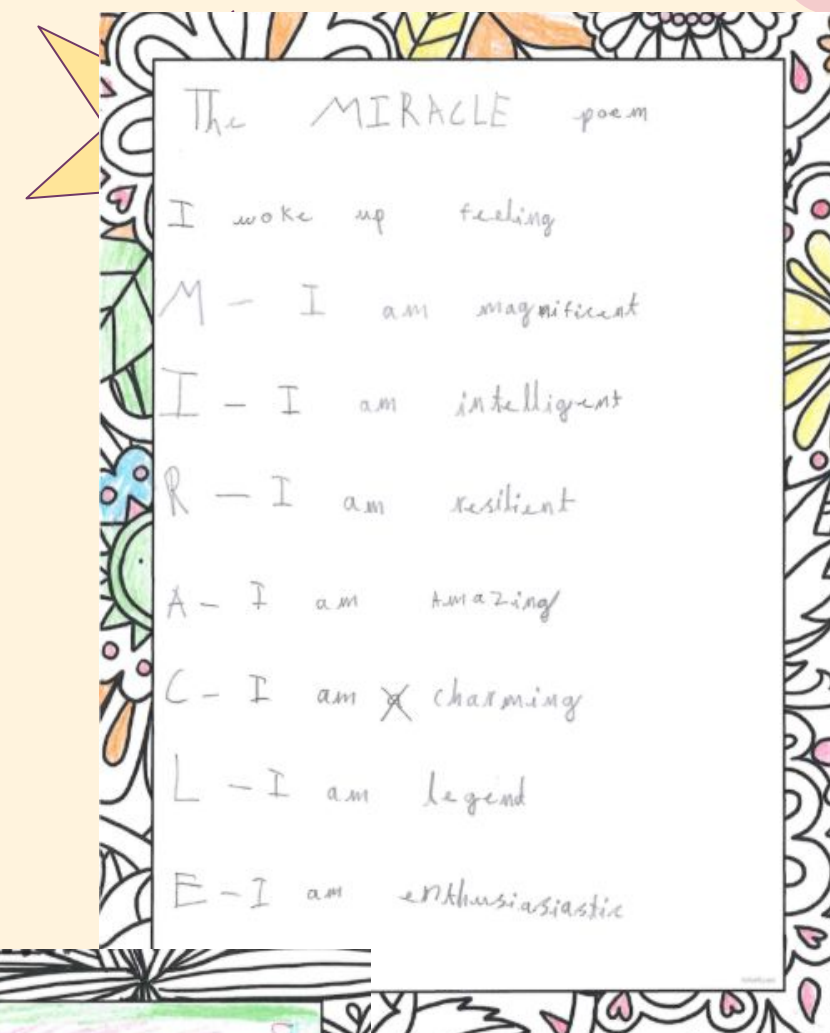


Year 3

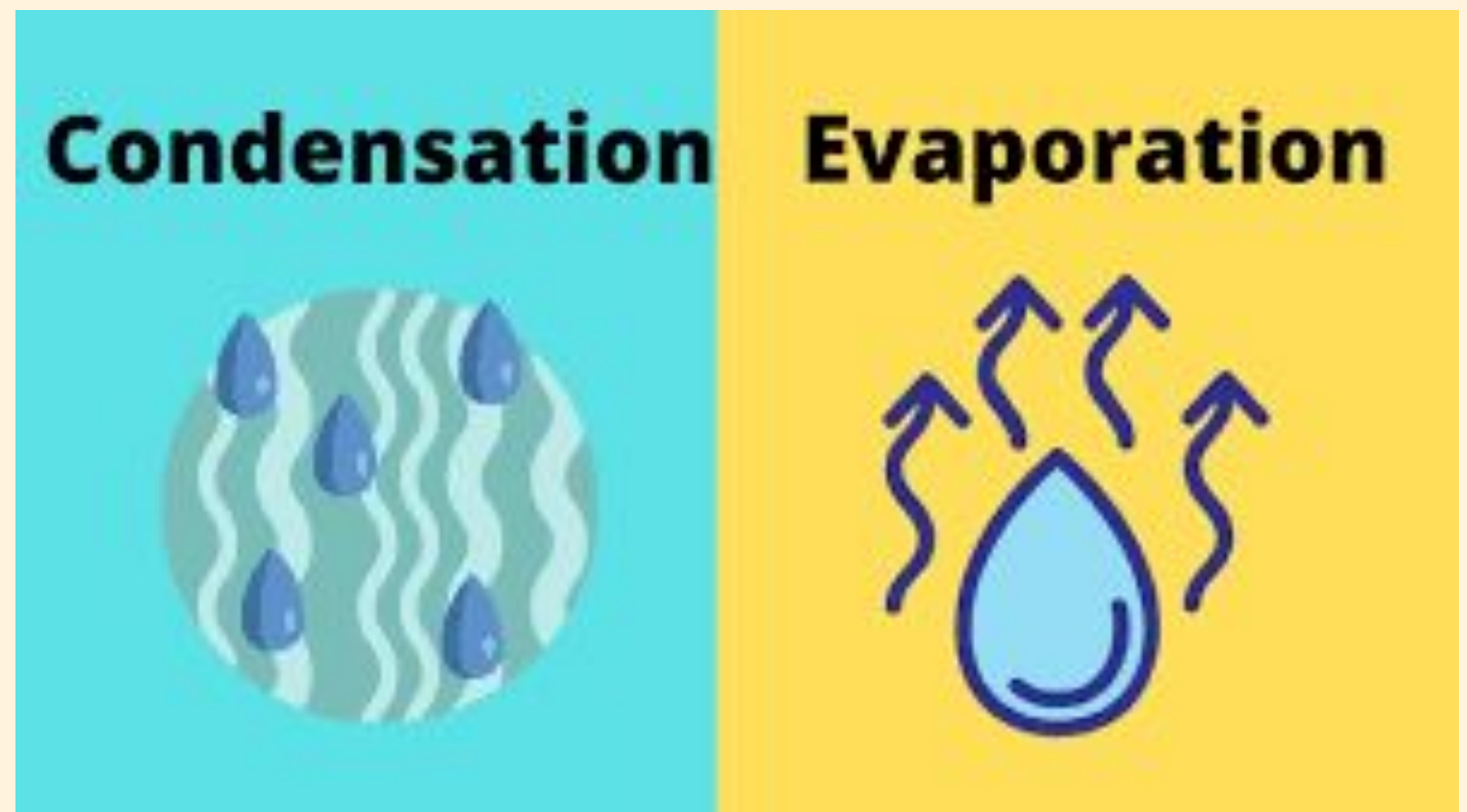
