## What we're learning this half term

### English

In English we will be learning to write a recount of our visit to Judy Woods. We will practise writing in the past tense, using time connectives and adjectives. We will also be writing our own bedtime stories!

### Maths

In maths we will be continuing to look at multiplication and division. We will start our new learning on capacity and temperature leading on to fractions.

### Geography

Our topic this half term is Why is Our World Wonderful. We will find out about amazing places in the UK and around the world, why oceans and natural habitats are special and how we can look after them.

### Science

This half term we are going to learn about animals including humans. We will find out about life cycles, how animals are adapted to their environment and the importance of exercise and hygiene.
