What we're learning this half term

English

Writing

We will be continuing our work around the book 'Arthur and the Golden Rope' where we will be writing our own poems, blog posts and character descriptions. We will be focusing on our use of fronted adverbials and different conjunctions to help our writing flow.

Reading

In reading we will be reading 'Anisha, Accidental Detective' by Serena Patel to develop our comprehension, justify our inferences and develop broader vocabulary.

Maths

We will be linking our learning of multiplication facts to finding the area of different shapes. Then, we will be starting to learn the formal method for short multiplication.

History

In history, we will be learning all about the Anglo-Saxons. We will be identifying key features of Anglo-Saxon settlements and making inferences about artefacts. We will also suggest reasons for the Anglo-Saxon invasion of Britain and how their beliefs changed.

Science

In science, we will be learning about Energy: Sound and vibrations. Children will learn how sounds are made and how they can be heard through different mediums. They will be able to explain the relationship between vibration strength and volume.

PSHE

We are starting our new Story Project book called, 'The Proudest Blue.' We will be discussing how to be respectful to people who share different beliefs and we will be looking at the impact of bullying on mental wellbeing.
