What we're learning this half term

English

In reading, we will study Viking boy by Tony Bradman. It follows a young Viking named Gunnar on a quest for revenge, blending action with historical facts about Viking life, culture, and mythology.

In writing, we will be creating our own campfire stories.

Maths

This term, we will build on our learning to understand fraction multiplying and dividing and how these connect with decimals and percentages.

Geography

Why do the oceans matter? Why is the marine environment suffering? We will dig deeper to understand the impact of humans on coral reefs and collect, present and evaluate data to show our findings.

Science

Mixtures and separations: We will research what solids, liquids and gases are made from and identify the best methods to separate mixtures.

PSHE
