What we're learning this half term

English

In English we will continue to focus on grammar and punctuation we have previously learnt and use this in our new units of writing.

Maths

In maths, we will revisit addition and subtraction looking at adding and taking away two 2-digit numbers. We will continue on by learning about fractions.

History

We thoroughly enjoyed our geography last half term and will be swapping over to history. In our topic of 'What is a Monarch?' We will look into the role of a Monarch, coronations and how William the Conqueror became the King of England.

Science

We will be looking at plants, their life cycle and the process of germination. We will also experiment on plant growth in different conditions.

PSHE

Our story this half term is 'The Girl at the Front of the Class'. This unit of work explores themes of kindness and acceptance. It focuses on a young refugee and the acts of kindness that help her feel at home in her new world.
