What we're learning this half term

English

In reading, we will be finishing the last part of Planet Omar story - Planet Omar: Unexpected Super Spy by Zanib Mian. We will then use Stone Age Boy to recap and consolidate our learning about the Stone Age from earlier in the year. This theme will also link with our writing where we will use our knowledge to support us writing a range of outcomes consolidating all skills taught so far.

Maths

We will continue our topic of measurement before moving on to fractions.

History

Our new topic question is 'How have children's lives changed?'. We will investigate and compare our lives now to children's lives in different periods of history.

Art

In Art, we will be developing our drawing skills through the theme of Growing Artists.

Science

In science, we will be building on our Year 2 learning of plants. We will investigate what plants need to survive, identify the structure and function of the parts of a plant and look at how water is transported.
