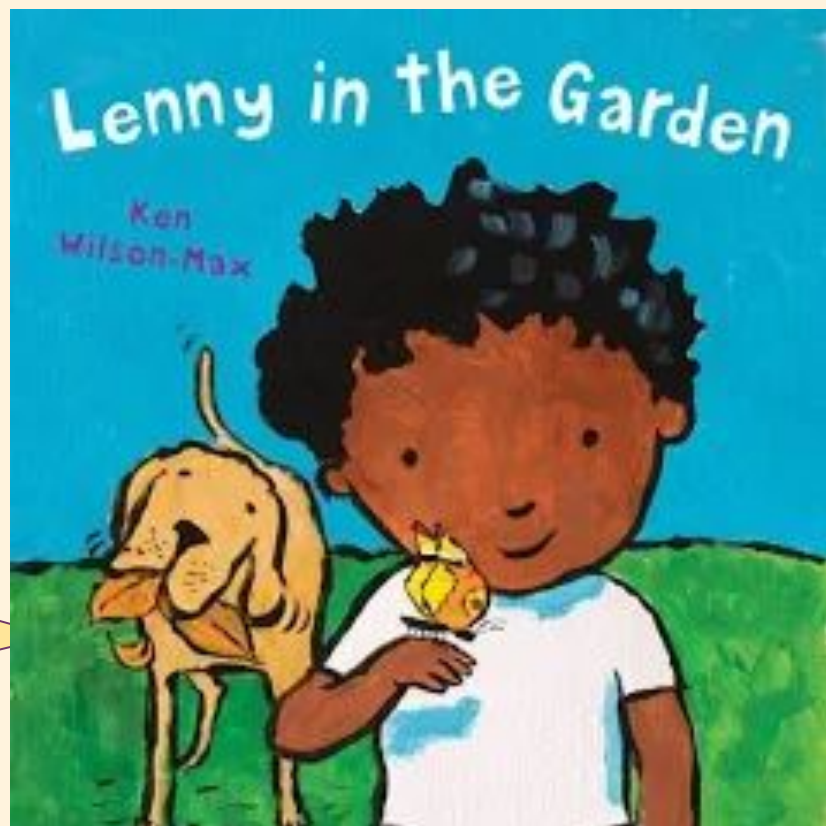

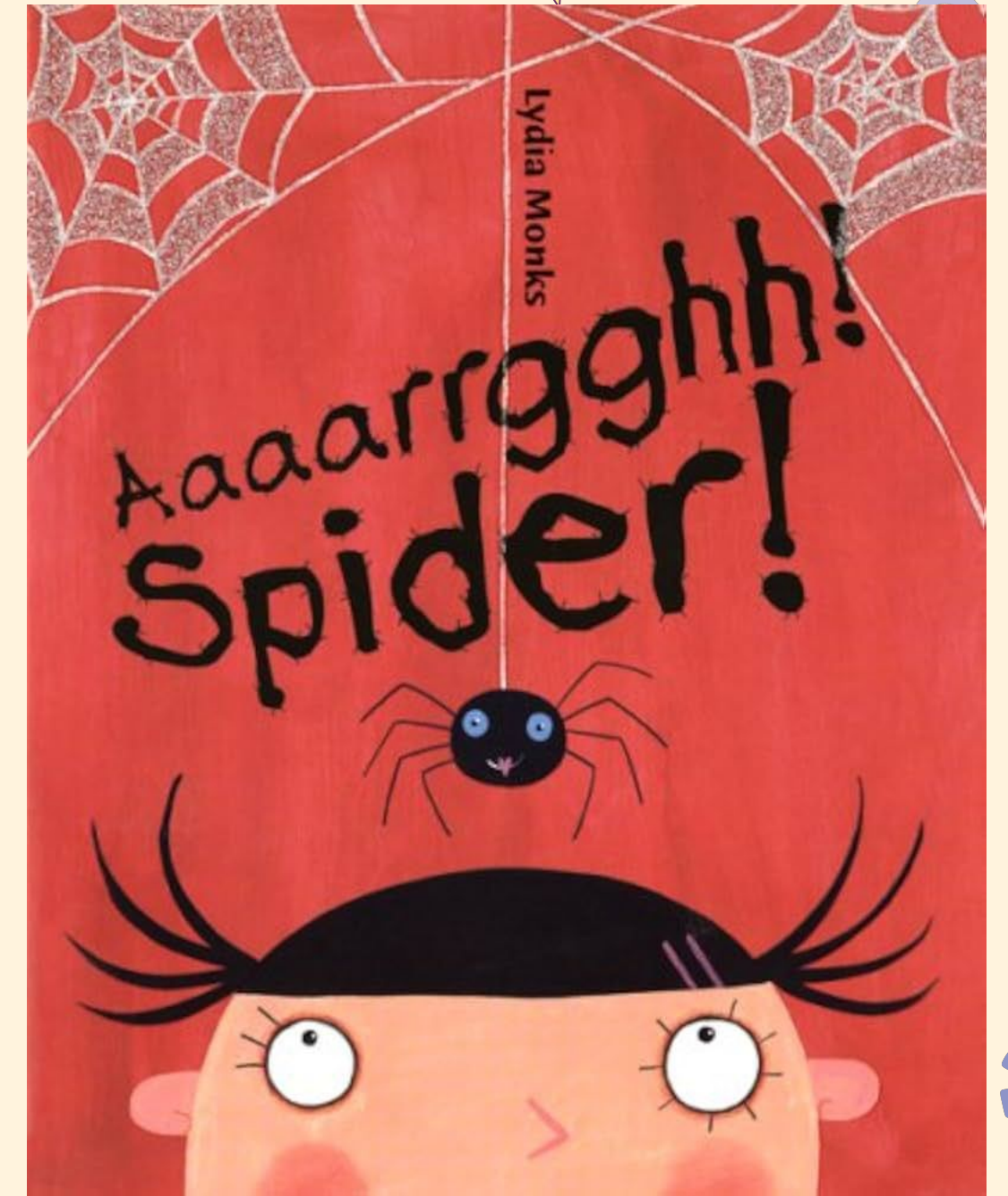


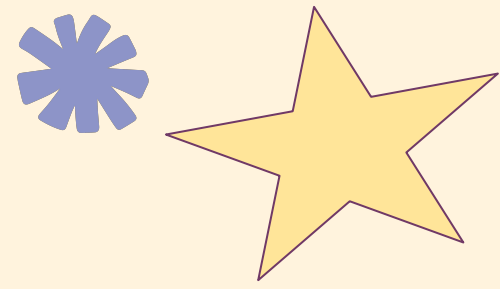
# \* Reception

This week, we started reading the story *Arghh Spider!* We talked about whether we would like a spider as a pet and drew a new home for the spider after the family threw him out.

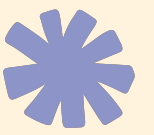
In Maths, we practised subitising to 7. We explored different ways to make 7 and even began taking away from this number.

# Year 1

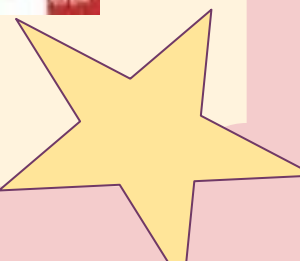
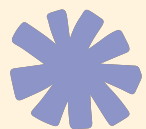
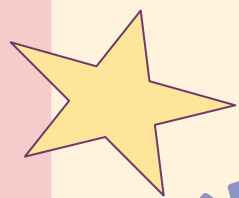
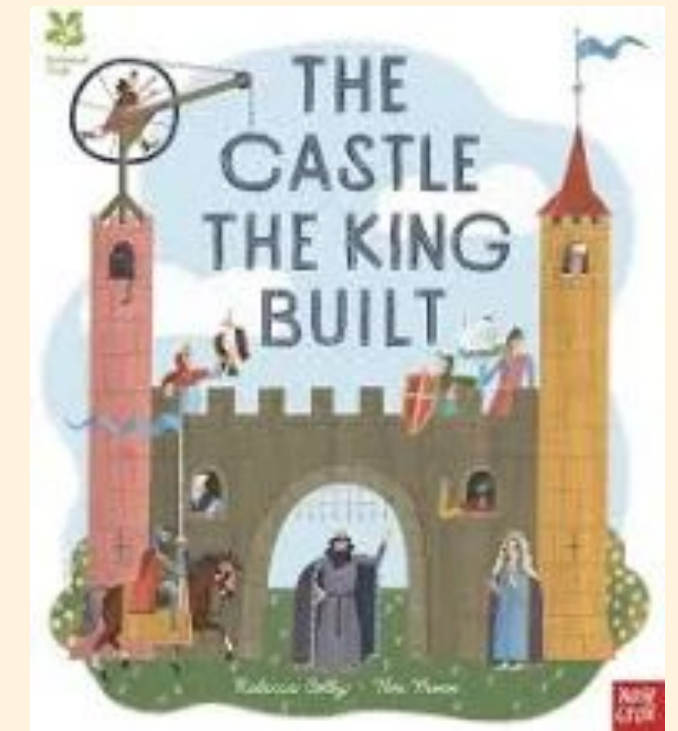


In maths, we have continued to learn about measurements. We have enjoyed weighing objects using cubes and also learning about capacity.

# Year 2

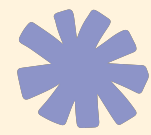
In English we have been looking at adverts and what features they include for us to use in our final posters for 'Farnham's Summer Fair'.



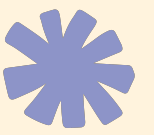
In maths we have been working out mixed addition and subtraction number problems to finish off our learning. We have compared number sentences to see which addition number sentence is greater or less than.

In DT we have been making delicious wraps! We had to make sure they were balanced including some protein, fruit or vegetables and some dairy to make sure we are strong and healthy.





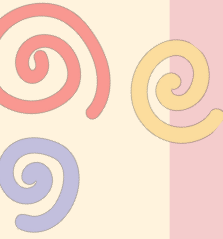
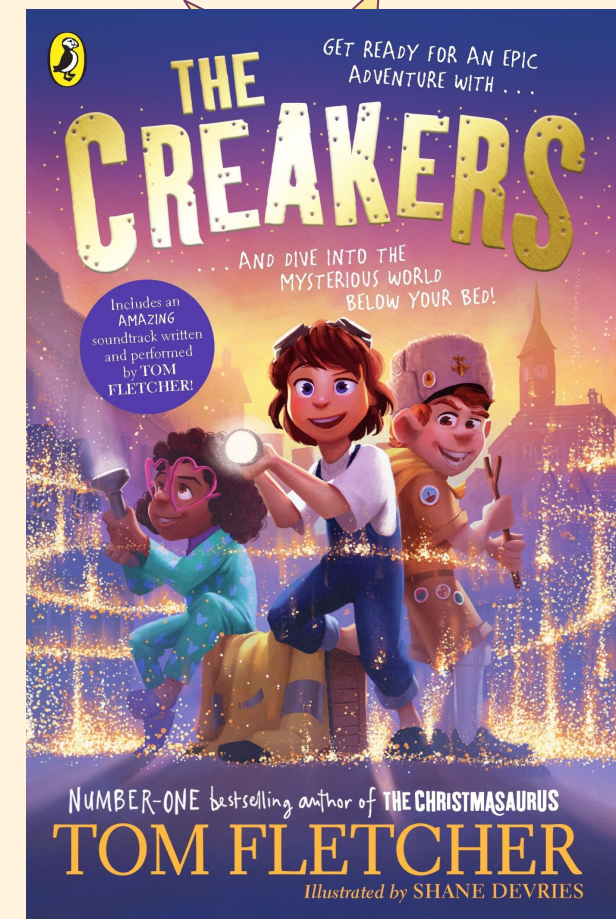
# Year 3

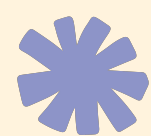


In reading, we have started our new text *The Creakers* by Tom Fletcher. We are eager to find out where all the parents of Whiffington Town have disappeared to.

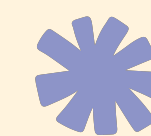

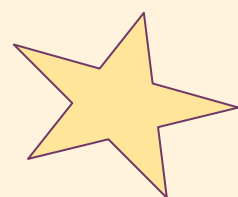


# Year 4

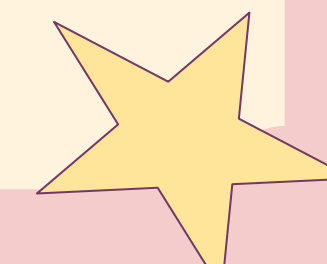
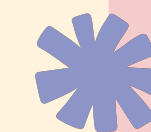


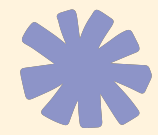
In reading, we have enjoyed continuing our novel by Nizrana Fadoor and exploring the emotions of the characters as they start their journey.

In maths, we have been focusing on developing our understanding of tenths. We have drawn our own bar models and have explored their representations as decimals.

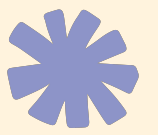


In history, we have enjoyed learning about the story of how the Mayans were gifted the cacao tree.





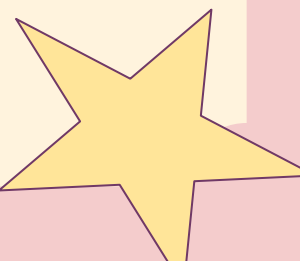
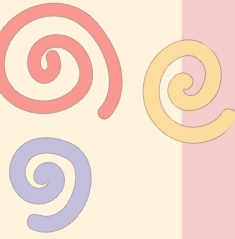
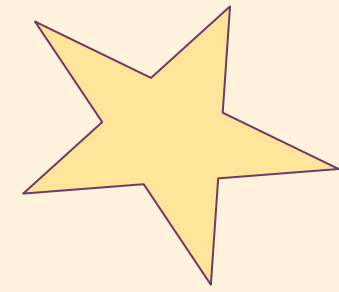
# Year 5
