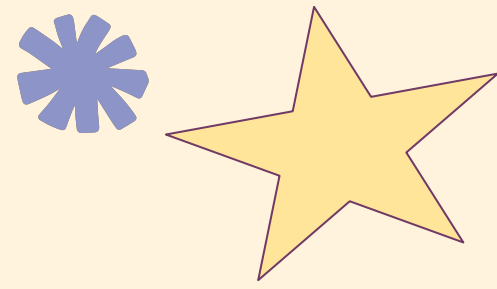
Reception

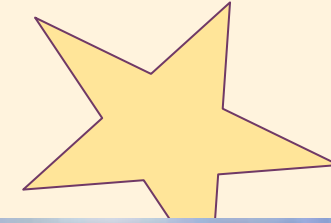
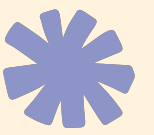
In maths, we recapped odd and even numbers. We used the Numberblocks to help us explore whether numbers were odd or even by looking carefully at how they could be grouped.

We also went on a school trip to Judy Woods, where we enjoyed searching for different minibeasts and exploring the outdoors.





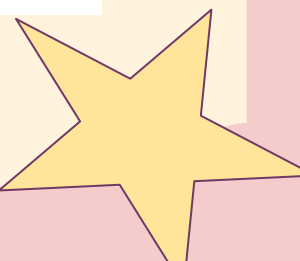
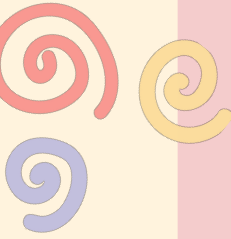
Year 1

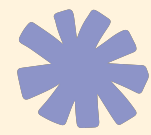


On Monday we had the best time at Harlow Carr. We amazed the staff leading our workshop with our knowledge of plants and were all amazing ambassadors of our school.

In maths we have been learning about equal and unequal groups.

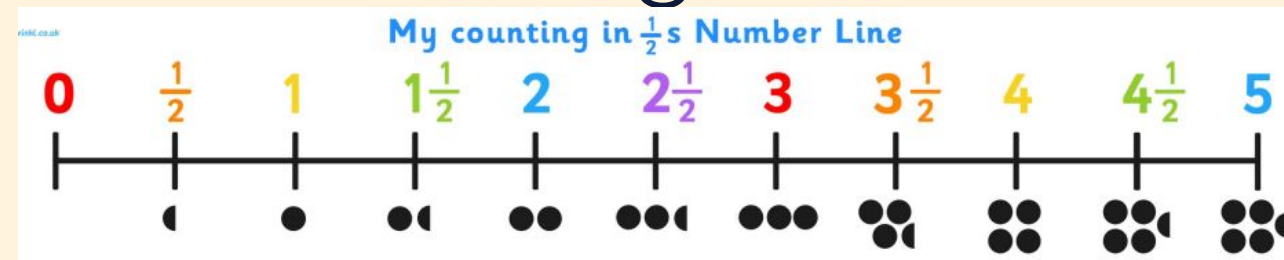




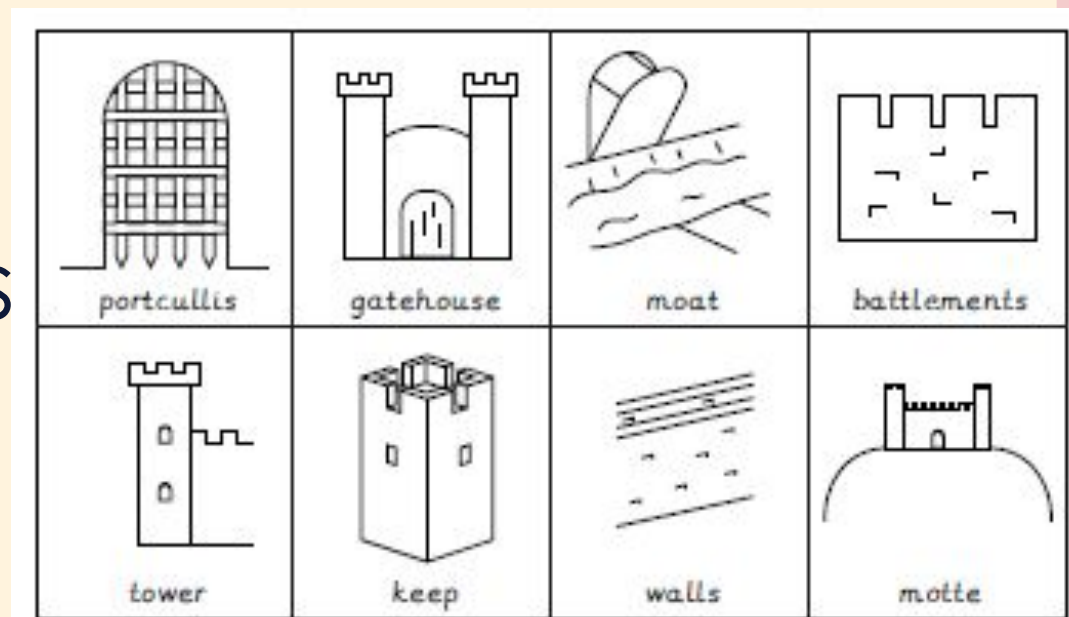
Year 2

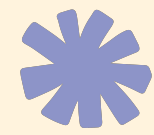
In English we have looked at rhetorical questions and finished off publishing our adverts for 'Farnham's Summer Fair'.

In maths we have been looking at fractions and started with 'a half'. We have understood how many parts it should have and started making our 'fractions leaflets',

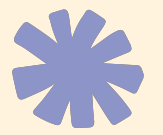
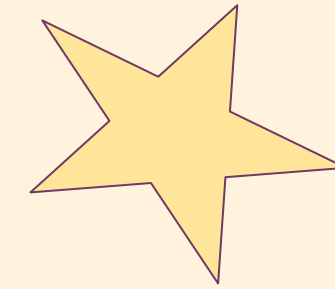


In history we have nearly finished learning about monarchs. This week we have looked at the structures of a castle and why they were constructed that way. We are looking forward to making our own after the holidays!





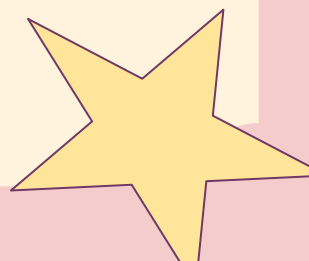
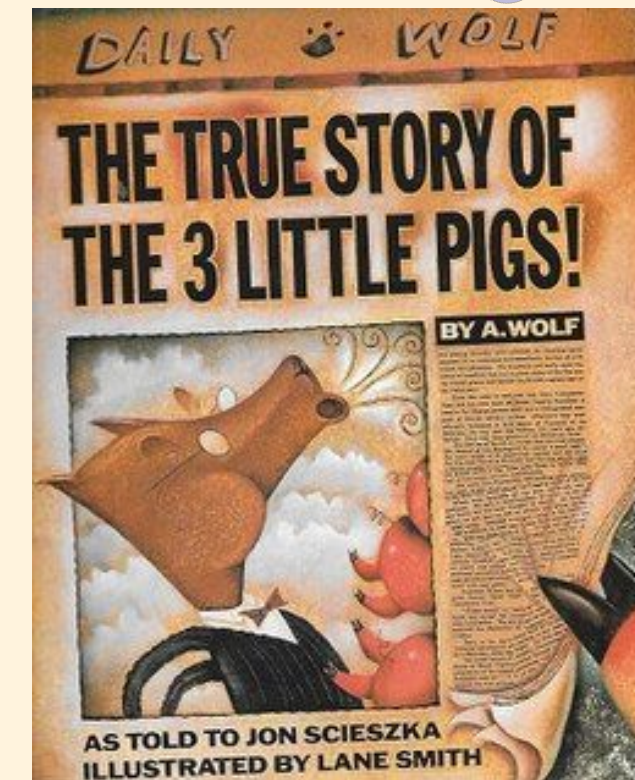
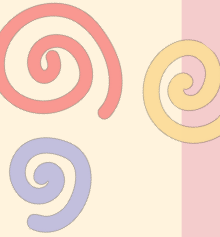
Year 3

In history, we have been learning about the decline of the maya civilisation and have looked at historical evidence to support claims.

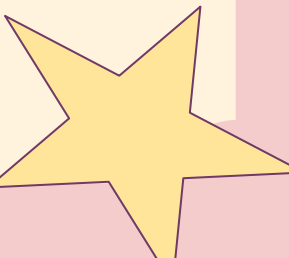
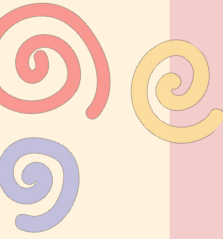
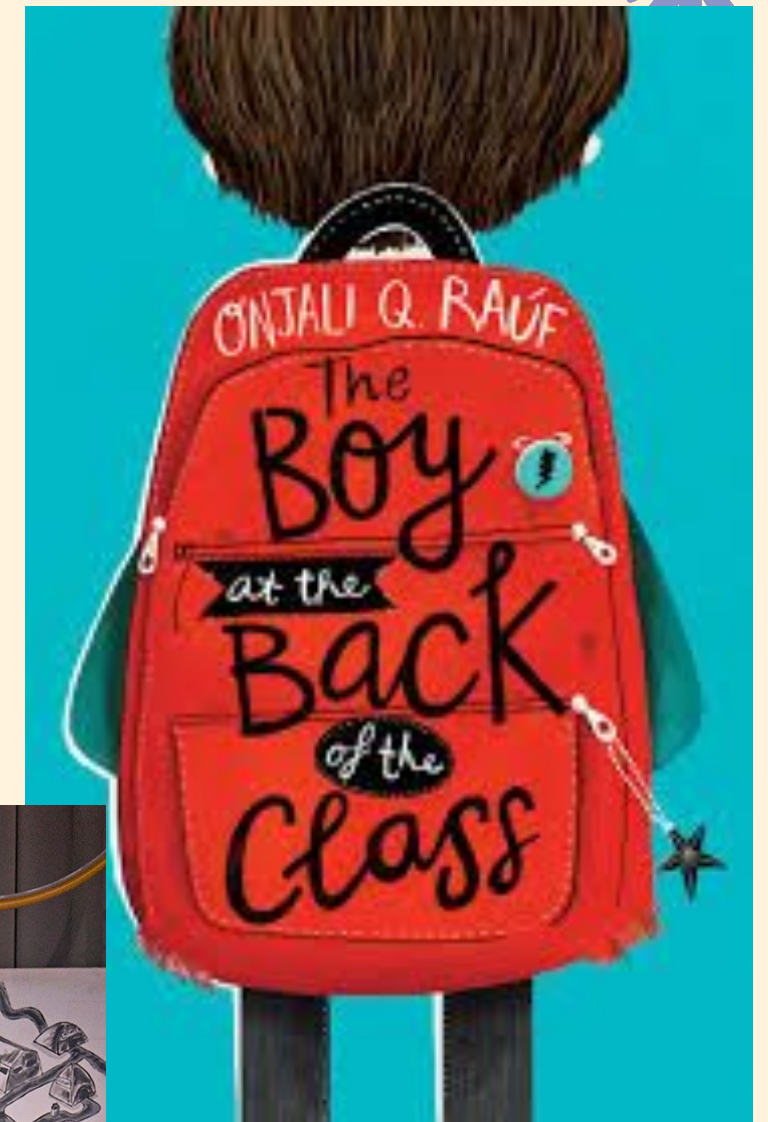


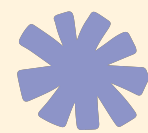
Year 5

It was heart wrenching, yet hilarious at the same time.



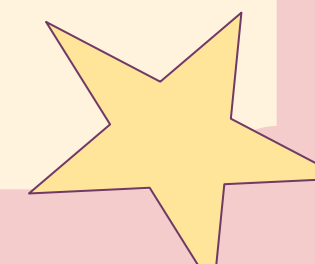
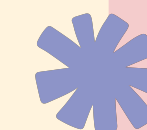
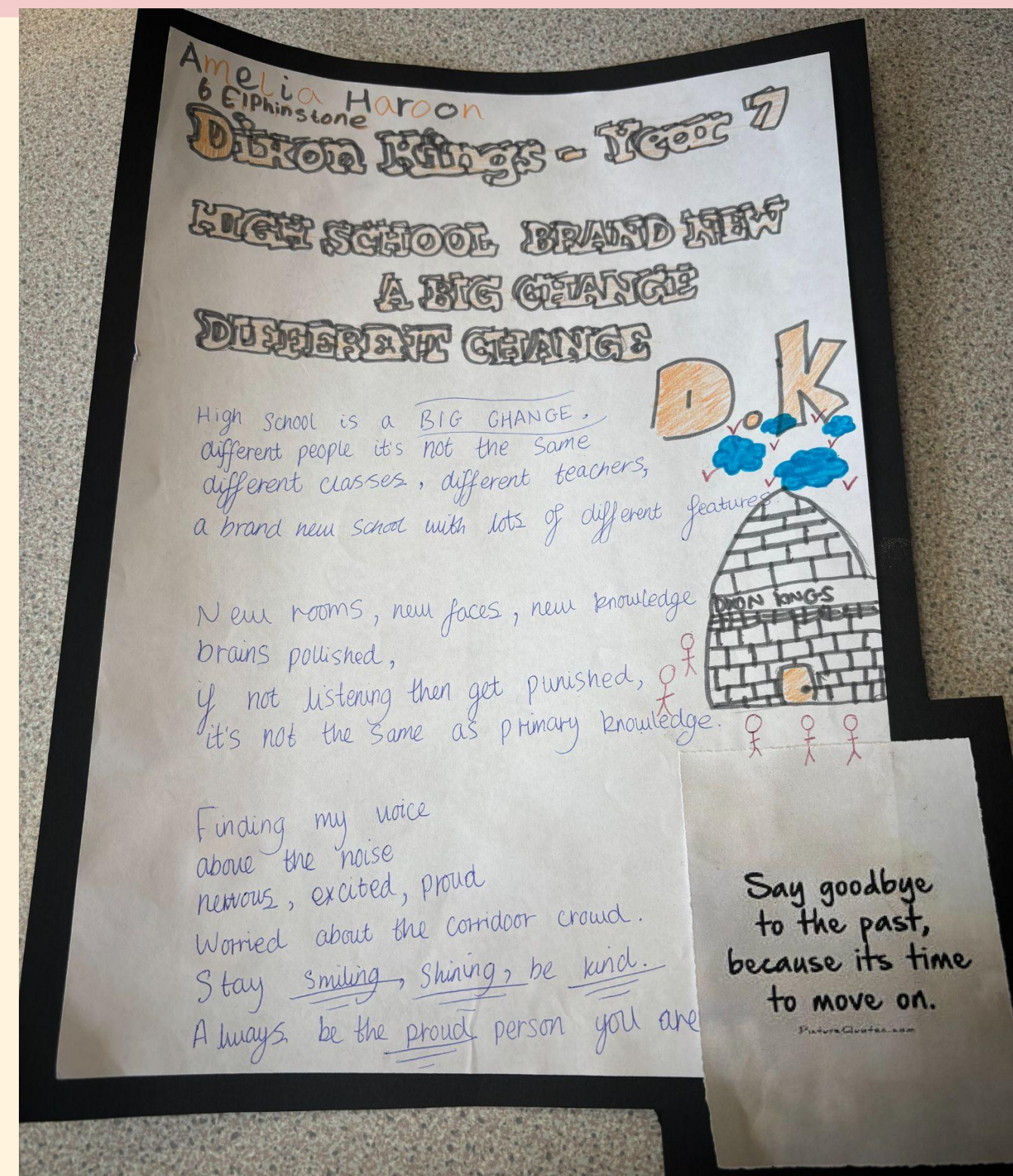


Year 6
