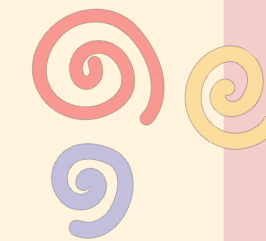
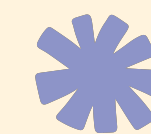
Nursery

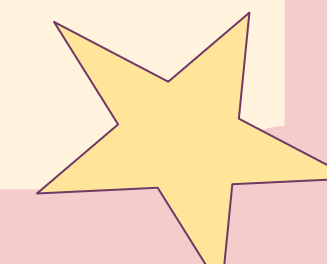
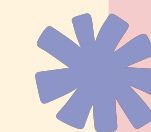
Reception

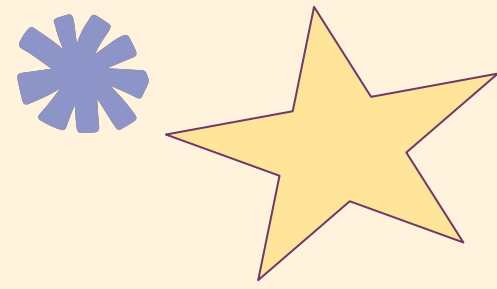

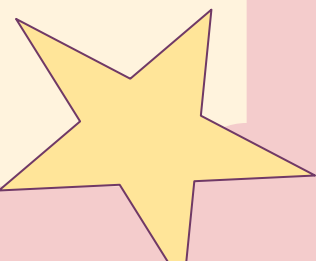
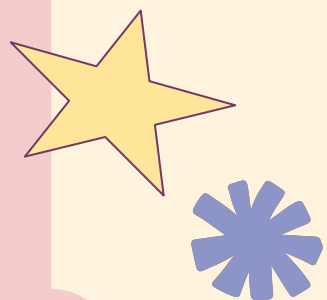


Year 1

We enjoyed listening to 'Oceans and seas' on NowPressPlay to help us to learn facts to support our writing in English.



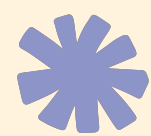
Year 2

We have learnt about the process of creating textiles from wool and did our own weaving using wool and felt.



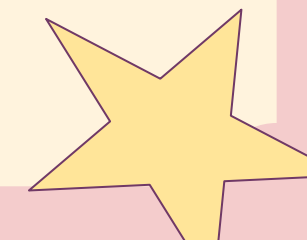
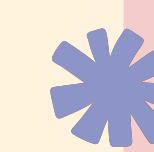
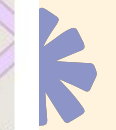
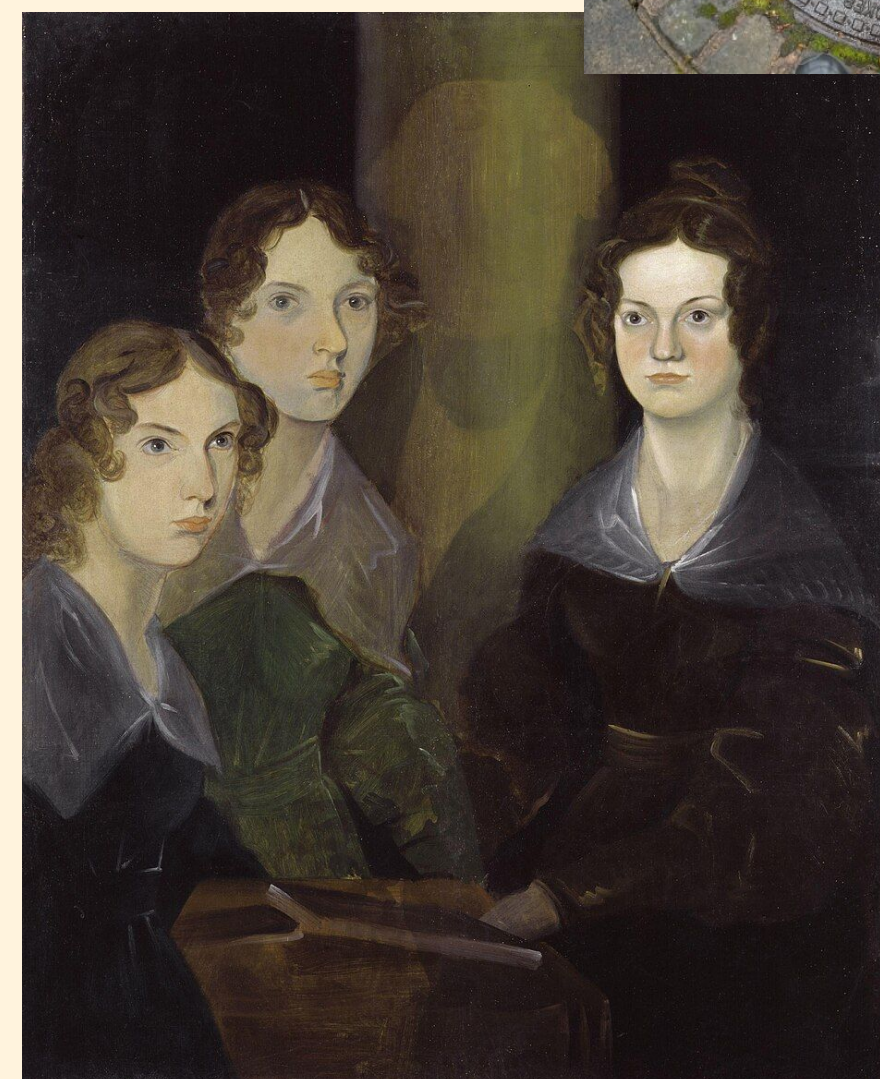
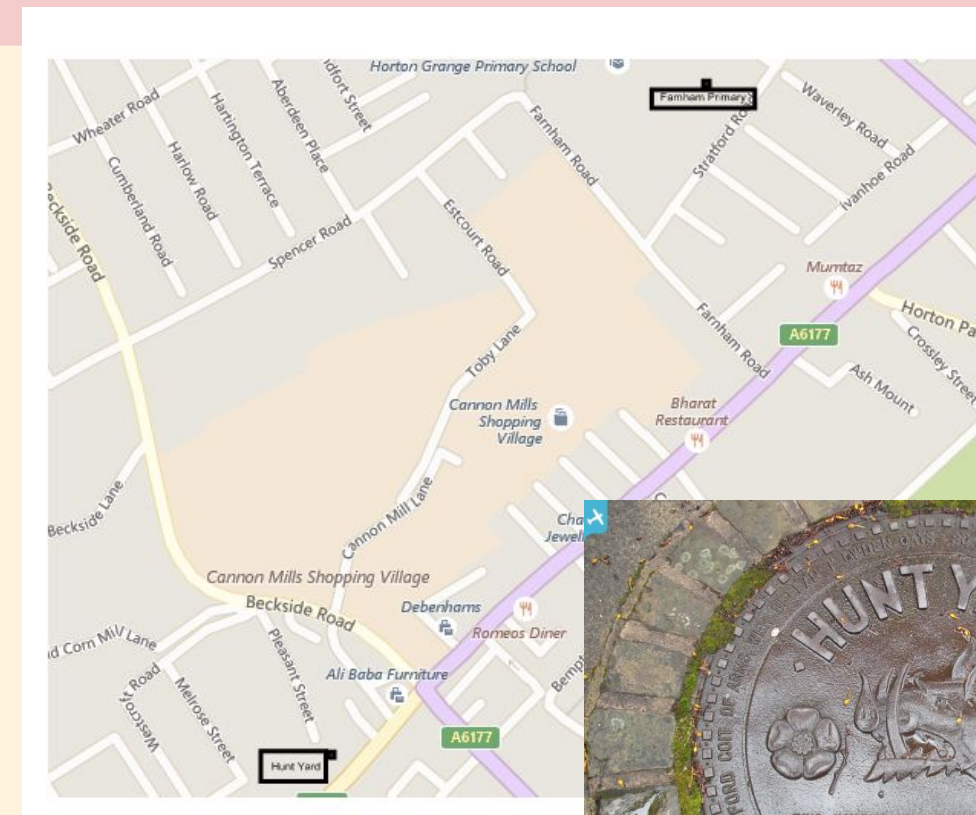


Year 3

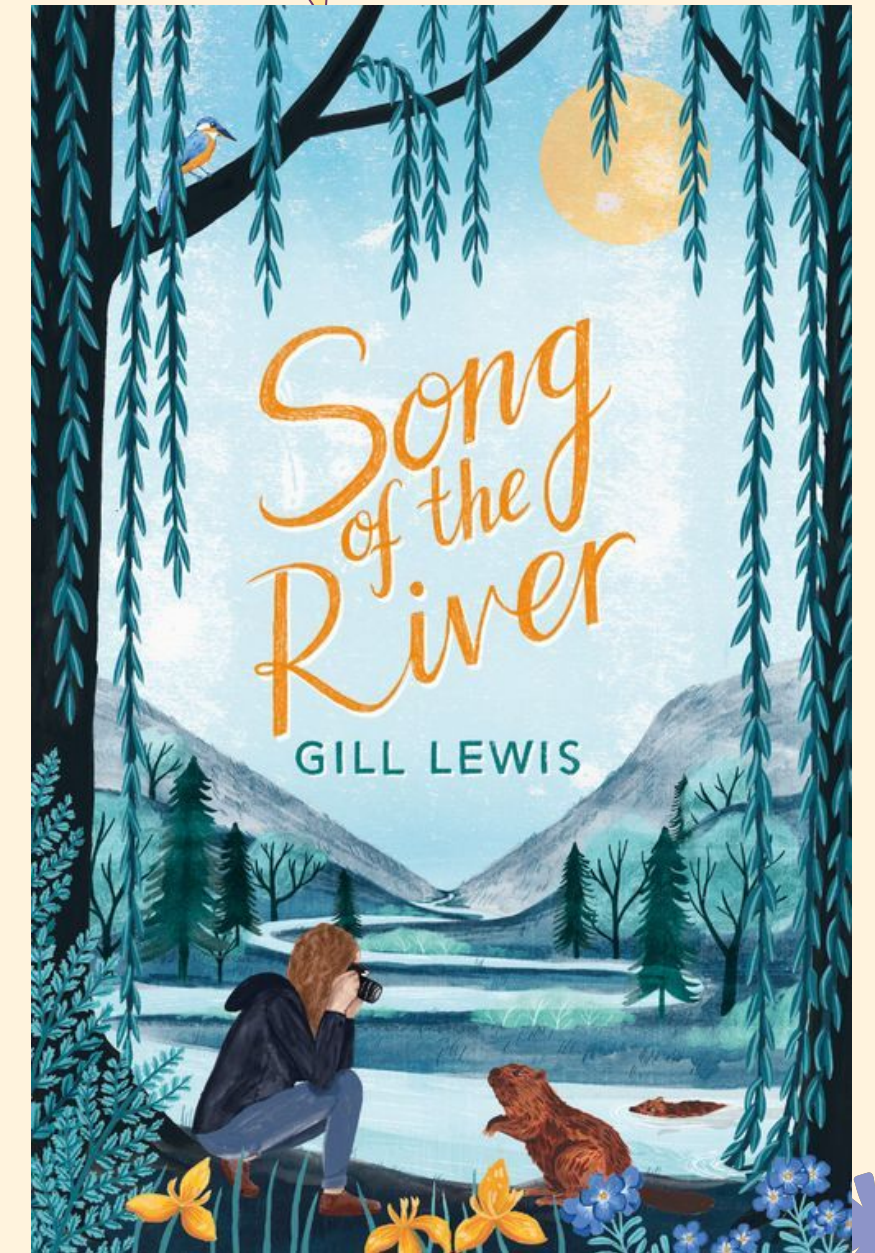

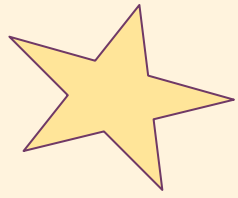
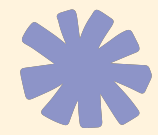


Year 4

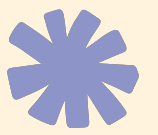

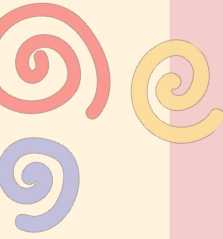
Year 5

Did you know, the original building had science labs upstairs in Year 6, a gym and even a swimming pool !

In writing, we learnt how Margaret McMillan fought for the rights of 'slum children' and how Bradford was the first city in the UK to provide free school meals. These were cooked at Green Lane School and distributed to all the schools in Bradford. 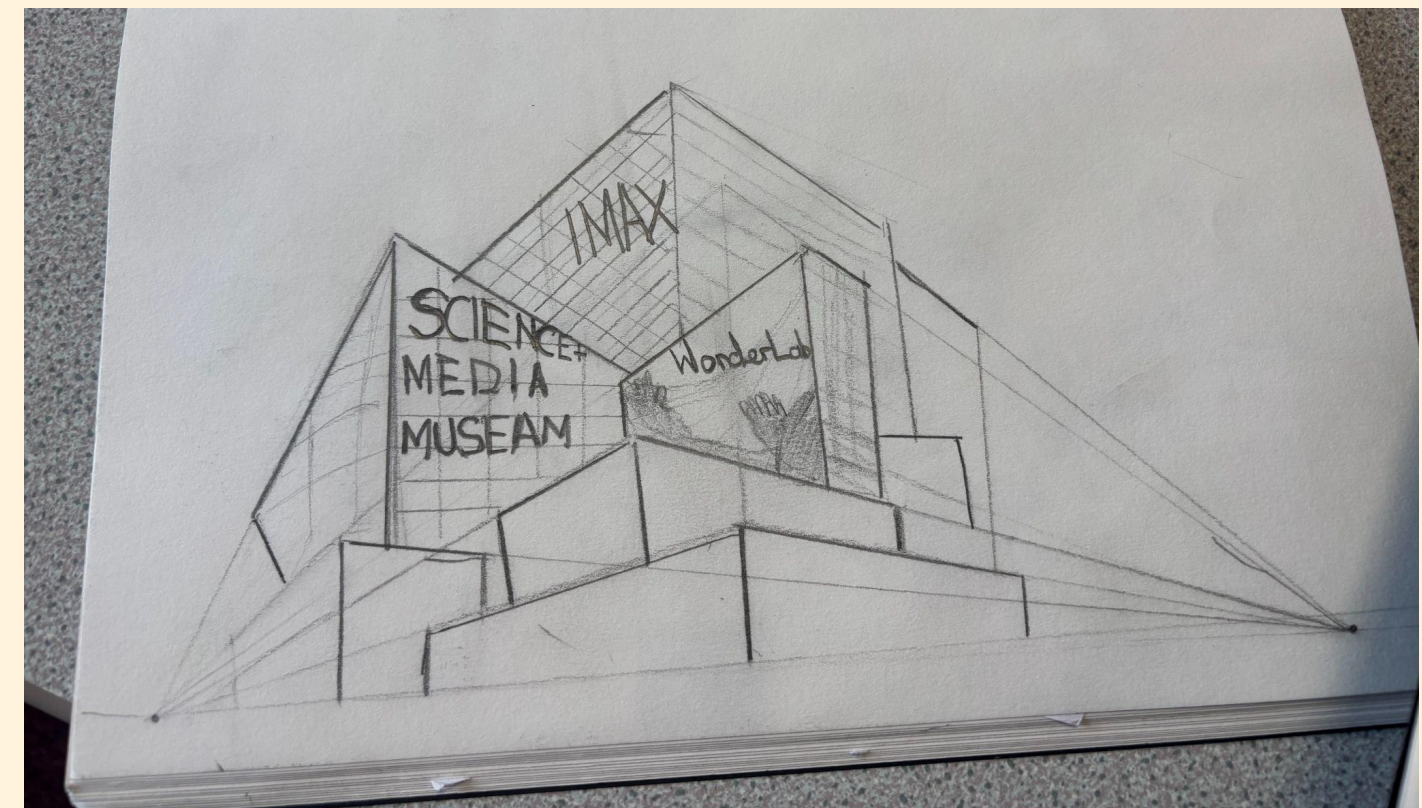
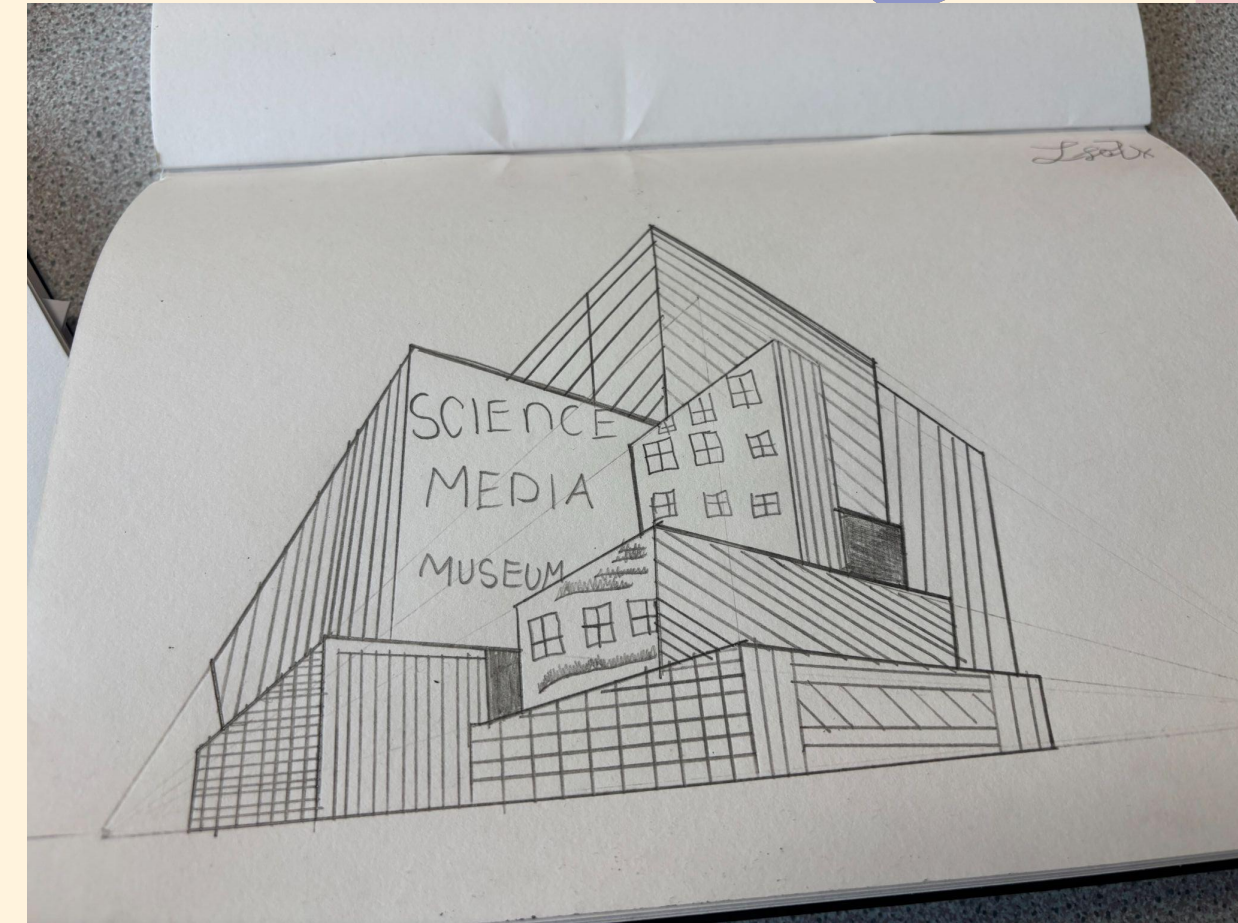


Year 6
