What we're learning this half term

English

In reading, we will be continuing to read *The Creakers* by Tom Fletcher. We are eager to find out what a creaker is and where the parents have gone. We apply the writing skills we have learnt this year to write a range of texts including a recount of the story of *The Bradford Boar*, a biography on the author Tom Fletcher as well as a focus on digital literacy and real life events.

Maths

We will start by continuing our learning on measurement including weight and mass (kg and g) and volume and capacity (L and ml). We will then move on to shape and time.

Geography

In geography, we will be considering the question "Are all settlements the same?". We will use Ordnance Survey maps of our local area as well as compare land use in our local area to land use in New Delhi.

DT

In DT, we will be researching where foods come from. We will learn about seasonal foods before we taste some and use them to make a seasonal tart.

Science

In science, we will be consolidating all our learning from Year 3 and making links between them in our topic 'Making Connections'.
