What we're learning this half term

English

Planet Omar - Reading

In year 3, we will begin to start a reading lesson every day in the morning. We will be reading the story Planet Omar by Zanib Mian. We will begin with lots of predictions and exploring the characters!

In writing this half term we will be consolidating simple sentences and punctuation using lots of colourful semantics!

Maths

Place Value -

We will be looking at numbers and place value, looking at partitioning numbers and estimating on number lines.

PSHEE

As part of our PSHEE lessons we will be reading the story 'Ruby's Worry.' This unit will help illustrate worries and that everyone experiences these differently and how to get help if they feel overwhelming. This will be really helpful for families to discuss at home as the children may feel various emotions as they return back to school.

Art

Linking to our Stone Age topic we are discovering how and why ancient ancestors made art. We will explore prehistoric painting, experimenting with natural materials to make home made paints.

Science

In science we will be starting our learning looking at 'animals - movement and nutrition'. We will look at skeletons, bones, muscles and what animals need to eat to stay healthy.
