What we're learning this half term

English

In writing, we are studying the picture book, 'The Journey' by Francesca Sanna. We will be focusing on recapping essential grammar skills and sentence structures.

In reading, we will be using the book 'The Final Year' by Matt Goodfellow to develop our comprehension, justify our inferences and develop broader vocabulary.

Maths

To start our maths topic we will be looking at numbers to 10,000,000, multiplying and dividing by 10, 100 and 1000, rounding and short and long division methods.

History

We will be investigating the Golden Age of Baghdad, exploring its role as a global hub for scholars and innovators. Children will examine groundbreaking advancements in medicine, astronomy and mathematics, discovering the lasting impact these discoveries have on our modern lives.

Science

Circulation and health: We will explore aspects of our lifestyle that keep us and our heart healthy, whilst investigating what makes our heart rate increase.

RE

In RE, we will explore the question: What words can be used to describe God? Children will consider how different religions and worldviews describe God, reflect on the meaning of these descriptions, and discuss how beliefs can influence people's lives and values.
